



# HEARTHY HEARING HABITS



Being able to hear well has benefits well beyond staying connected with loved ones. It helps keep you safe — you need to hear car horns and smoke alarms for them to help. And it improves balance, leading to fewer falls. To help keep your hearing strong, try these tips.

### **Don't use cotton swabs**

You could damage your ear canal or eardrum. If your ears feel too waxy or dirty, or if you think there might be something in your ear, call your doctor.

### Keep the volume low

When you're wearing headphones or earbuds, be sure to keep them at a low volume. One way to know if it's too loud: Take them off. If you can still clearly hear what you were listening to, the volume is too high.

### Wear earplugs

They help block outdoor noise like lawn mowers and traffic, which can damage hearing. Earplugs work inside, too, for noisy blenders and vacuum cleaners.

### Get your hearing checked regularly

The earlier you detect hearing loss, the greater your chances of treating it successfully. Talk to your doctor about how often you should get your hearing.

# HOW TO REPORT AN INCIDENT OF SEXUAL ABUSE TO THE ARCHDIOCESE OF HARTFORD

If you have knowledge or suspect that a minor or vulnerable adult (an adult with an intellectual disability) has been sexually abused, in any manner, by personnel of the Archdiocese of Hartford, you are urged to report this information to:

In addition, you will be asked to follow up in writing with a detailed description of the facts involved in the incident. Specifics of this written report can be found in the <u>Policies and Procedures of the Archdiocese of Hartford Relating to Allegations of Sexual Misconduct Involving Minors and Vulnerable Adults</u>. This document is also available online at <u>www.archdioceseofhartford.org</u>. The Archdiocese of Hartford will report any and all incidents to the proper civil authorities.

Mandated reporters in the State of Connecticut are required by law to report any incident of sexual abuse involving a minor or vulnerable adult. We encourage any Non-Mandated persons to report such incidents to the proper authorities as well. We support your right to do so.

Incidents involving sexual abuse of minors (persons under the age of 18) should be reported to:



Once a written report of an incident of sexual abuse of a minor or vulnerable adult has been received, an investigation will be undertaken by, or on behalf of, the Archdiocese of Hartford.
