

The Tekakwitha Center, our partnership parish with Catholic Extension, serves the White Earth Nation.

"All Indian tribes have names for themselves." The largest Indian group in Minnesota calls itself Anishinaabe, which means 'the original people.' Europeans named them Oiibwe. No

one is exactly sure how this name developed. Perhaps it came from the Anishinaabe word 'ojib,' which describes the puckered moccasins worn by the people. Some Europeans had trouble saying Ojibwe, pronouncing it instead as Chippewa. But both these names refer to the same people." (https:// whiteearth.com/history provides this intro and more information)

During the next few months (from now until Easter), the Social Justice Committee will be working to educate our parish and raise funds to support the Tekakwitha Center which offers children on the White Earth Reservation a religious and spiritual education experience. Monetary donations help in at least two ways; they provide for the immediate needs of the Center and infuse funds into the local economy.

Cash, check (memo to say Tekakwitha Center), and online giving are options. There will be envelopes as well as online instructions.

St. Thomas will be participating in a **HomeFront** project for the 24th year this Spring.

HomeFront is a community-based, volunteer-driven home repair program that provides FREE repairs to low-income homeowners, thus enabling them to remain in their homes with an improved quality of life in Fairfield, Hartford and New Haven and Westchester Counties.

In 2022, HomeFront revitalized nearly 50 homes for families in need this year at no cost to them. Behind the numbers are local older adults on fixed incomes, persons with disabilities, single-parent households, veterans and low-income families in crisis due to illness or job loss. All of them now face this winter in warmer, safer, and healthier homes.
