Sharing Faith with our Youngsters – Why Not You!

Each year we have difficulty filling the role of teachers of the faith to our children. Yet, our baptism infuses us with sacramental grace to do just that. The following is a piece I wrote for *The Evangelist* at least 25 years ago ... before I was ordained to the Order of Deacon ... I pray that it will give you some encouragement to step forward.

Reflections of a Catechist – Richard Thiesen

The word "catechist" is derived from Latin and Greek words meaning "one who orally teaches Christian doctrine." I think it translates as "one who is willing to pass on our Catholic faith – the Christian message" – to the next generation." Who are these catechists? Ultimately you and me!

From an intellectual perspective, that's not so hard to grasp. The more difficult proposition, however, is simply put: "Why me?" When I was first asked to consider this role, I confess that my thoughts were negative. I thought of all the reasons I just couldn't do this. I have no time!

I also questioned my competency to fulfill this role. What do I have to offer? I'm not a teacher! I know the students will ask questions I can't answer. So, my initial reaction was to figure out a way to say "no" gracefully. But something within said: "Think about it for a few days ... bring it to prayer. How important is my faith ... important enough to share?"

Over the next week or so, I prayed for God's wisdom and, more importantly, the grace and courage to act on it. I thought about the message our youth incessantly receives from society about what is most important in their lives ... power, wealth, dominance, possessions, technology without personal contact with others ... the message that those on the margins of society are largely disposable, irrelevant to our secular measures of success.

I then thought about the counter-cultural message of Jesus – His message of love and forgiveness, of the dignity of each human person, of the need to serve rather than be served, of seeing Christ in the least of our sisters and brothers.

So, the question essentially became: As a Catholic Christian which message do I want our young people to carry forward into adulthood?

I decided to say "yes." I must tell you that it was an enlightening and rewarding experience. I hope it was the same for the students. I learned that, despite seemingly indifferent outward appearances, these young people really hunger for hope and meaning in their lives ... and that comes through their relationship with the person of Jesus Christ! That is why I believe the role of lay catechist is so utterly vital to God's Church today.

I enthusiastically encourage each of you to prayerfully reflect upon your potential role in the ministry of catechist.

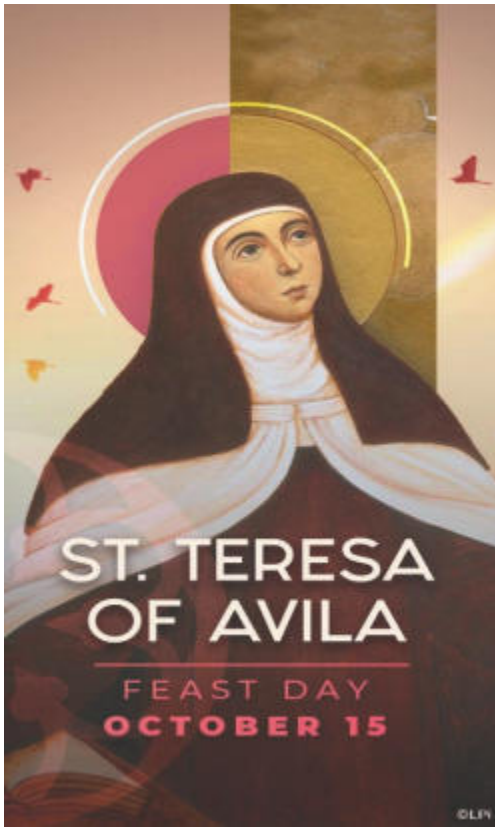
