IT'S A SYNOD - THE DIOCESE AND POPE FRANCIS WANTS TO HEAR FROM YOU!

What is a Synod?

Yes, you read this headline correctly! Last October, Pope Francis invited all Catholics to share their dreams and hopes ... their frustrations and concerns ... their experiences and ideas about the future mission of the Church. The process is called a Synod (from a Greek word meaning "assembly" or "meeting"). Rather than rely solely on the wisdom of those who govern God's Church, Pope Francis is asking all the faithful throughout the world to lend their voices.

When and how may I participate?

Dioceses and parishes world-wide will be involved. In the United States, by April 1 dioceses are expected to submit a summary of local discussions to the US Conference of Catholic Bishops which will then forward their summary to the Vatican. A working document will then be prepared for the world-wide Synod of Bishops in October 2023.




