
This is for all the mothers who:

- + Have sat up all night with sick toddlers in their arms, wiping up remnants of last night's supper saying: "It's OK honey, mommy's here."
- + Have been frozen to metal bleachers at football or soccer games instead of watching from the car, so that when their kids ask, "Did you see me?" they could say, "Of course, I wouldn't have missed it for the world," and mean it.
- + Have read "Goodnight, Moon" twice a night for a year. And then read it again "Just one more time."
- + Have taught their sons how to cook and their daughters how to make jump shots.

This day of admiration, honor, and love is:

- + For young mothers stumbling through diaper changes and sleep deprivation;
- + For mature mothers learning to let go;
- + For working mothers and stay-at-home mothers;
- + For single mothers, married mothers, adoptive and foster mothers, for grandmothers and Godmothers, and all who fulfill maternal roles;

May you feel the gentle touch of the Blessed Virgin on your shoulders as if to say: "Hang in there ... my Son will be with you always as He was and is with me."



SACRAMENTS

BAPTISM: is the greatest gift we can give to our children because it opens them up to Jesus. We welcome every family who desires baptism for their children, and who desire to raise their children in the Catholic faith. MARRIAGE: If you are contemplating entering into the Sacrament of Marriage and would like to inquire about the preparation process and subsequent celebration of Marriage at St. Clare's or Christ Our Light, please contact the parish office at least six months prior to a proposed date and time. We ask that you do not make commitments for the reception until you have met with Deacon Dick.
