

THE SUNDAY CONNECTION | LIVING THE GOSPEL IN OUR DAILY LIVES

Rest in the presence of God simply because God is God and you are you. This is all that is necessary. Out of this relationship will come inspiration, understanding, courage, constancy, truth, and virtues of all kind. We will find ourselves knowing the true meaning of things and developing a depth of insight that is not found following purely human venues. It is God who inspires and opens human hearts to see truth and beauty.

In God, we understand all of our relationships with a richer appreciation and come to know who Jesus, who speaks of God's kingdom, really is. The trust that is fostered from resting with the Divine One allows us to see that God's ways are not our ways. There is something bigger going on in this picture of life. 
FIRST READING | ISAIAH 50:4C-9A



Words of Solace from Pope Francis September 25, 2015 at Ground Zero

"The names of so many loved ones are written around the towers' footprints. We can see them, we can touch them, and we can never forget them.

Here, amid pain and grief, we also have a palpable sense of the heroic goodness which people are capable of... hands reached out, lives were given.

This place of death became a place of life, too, a place of saved lives, a hymn to the triumph of life over the prophets of destruction and death, to goodness over evil, to reconciliation and unity over hatred and division."

"Do this and remember me." On the night before Jesus died, He instructed His followers to remember, and as we do so today, His presence for us, in the Eucharist, is real.

The sacred duty of remembering continues to be an obligation and responsibility we share as a community of believers.



RCIA: A JOURNEY IN FAITH


Are you a Catholic who has never received the Sacrament of Confirmation? Or are you or any of your family members interested in becoming a member of the Catholic Church?



LECTORS: All men, women, and high school students are invited to proclaim the Scriptures at all Masses.


ALTAR SERVING: All boys and girls of the parish who have completed the third grade are invited to serve as acolytes for weekend liturgies and special liturgical celebrations.

SACRAMENTAL LIFE AT OLS

BAPTISM: First time parents are asked to attend a pre-Baptismal class, available by appointment at the Parish Center.

EUCHARIST: This joyful celebration takes place each year as young girls and boys are welcomed into the full community of faith at our Parish.

CONFIRMATION: A yearly journey of all 8th graders who have been enrolled in our Religious Education program for at least 2 years, or attend Catholic School.

MARRIAGE: Contact the Parish Center at least 6 months in advance of your desired wedding date so preparations can be made for your celebration.

ANNOINTING OF THE SICK: If a member of your family has become sick or hospitalized, please contact us.

VISITATION OF THE SICK: Any parishioner who is homebound and would like to regularly receive the Eucharist may contact the Parish Center to schedule a visit.

FUNERALS: Please notify the Parish Center at the time of your loved one's death so that we may assist in the planning of the funeral.
