





### EUCCHARISTIC MINISTERS:


Parishioners (age 18+) are always needed to assist in the distribution of Communion during weekend Masses and liturgical celebrations.

**LECTORS:** All men, women, and high school students are invited to proclaim the Scriptures at all Masses.

**ALTAR SERVERS:** All boys and girls of the parish who have completed the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade qualify to serve as acolytes for weekend liturgies and special celebrations. Consider signing up!

**HOSPITALITY TEAM:** These ministers help create a culture and spirit of hospitality, and also ensure the liturgy flows smoothly.

**MUSIC MINISTRY:** We now welcome singers and a variety of instrumentalists to lead us in singing God's praises at worship. Any who are interested should contact Michael O'Malley at the Parish Center to learn more.



### ADORATION/BENEDICTION:

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is held on the first Friday of each month at *Our Lady of the Snows Church* following the daily 12:10pm Mass and concluding with Benediction at 2pm.

### SPECIAL PROGRAMS:

Throughout the year, we also offer various other programs and events for the faithful of all ages, including video series and faith sharing groups.

## SACRAMENTAL LIFE AT OLS

**BAPTISM:** This joyous first sacrament is celebrated Sundays at 1pm. First time parents are asked to attend a pre-Baptismal class with one of our priests, by appointment at the Parish Center.

**RECONCILIATION:** This sacrament is celebrated at both of our churches every Saturday before Mass; at CSB from 3-3:45pm and at OLS from 5-5:25pm, or by appointment.

**FIRST EUCHARIST:** This celebration takes place each year as young girls and boys are welcomed into the full community of faith at our Parish.

**CONFIRMATION:** A yearly journey of all 8<sup>th</sup> graders who have been enrolled in our Religious Ed program for at least 2 years, or who attend Catholic School.

**MARRIAGE:** Contact the Parish Center at least 6 months in advance of your desired wedding date so preparations can be made for your celebration.

**ANNOINTING OF THE SICK:** If a member of your family has become sick or hospitalized, please contact us.

**RCIA:** The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is the ancient rite and ritual by which an adult enters into full communion with the Catholic Church. Have questions or thinking about taking the journey of becoming a Catholic, or want to complete your Sacraments of Initiation? Contact the Parish Center for more information.

**VISITATION OF THE SICK:** Any parishioner who is homebound and would like to regularly receive the Eucharist may contact the Parish Center to schedule a visit.

**FUNERALS:** Please notify the Parish Center at the time of your loved one's death so that we may assist in the planning of the funeral.
