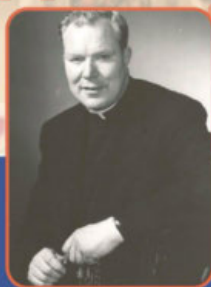

ALL SAINTS DAY SCHEDULE

Friday, Nov. 1 marks the Solemnity of All Saints, a Holy Day of Obligation. On this day the Church honors all the saints of heaven, God's holy ones, both known and unknown to us. We celebrate all the holy men, women, and children who, throughout the ages, exemplified the faith; whose lives mirrored the Paschal Mystery of Christ in profound ways.



This solemnity honors all the saints; in particular those who are not individually recognized throughout the year. This day, coupled with the commemoration of all the faithful departed (All Souls) on Nov. 2, stands at the beginning of November, a month in which we remember and pray for the dead.

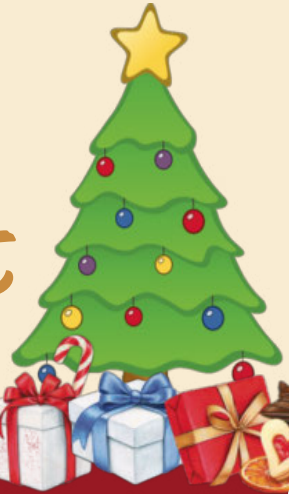

A NURTURING COMMUNITY

FRIDAY MORNING COMPANY: Each Friday, men and women meet in the Gathering Room to break open the Sunday Scriptures and pray about how God is calling them to live out His Word.

BIBLE STUDY: Throughout the year, parishioners gather to explore scripture and discuss the message of Christ and important teachings of the church. Check the bulletin for more information about these faith-filled learning experiences!

RCIA: The *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults* is the ancient rite and ritual by which an adult enters into full communion with the Catholic Church. Have questions or thinking about taking the journey of becoming Catholic? Contact the Parish Center for more information.

CURSILLO: Cursillo groups are meant to expand your prayer life and foster continuous spiritual growth as well as enrich your knowledge about Scripture and the Catholic faith. They will also equip you to spread the Word of God in your everyday life.

SERVING AT GOD'S ALTAR

EUCCHARISTIC MINISTERS:

Parishioners (age 18+) are always needed to assist in the distribution of Communion during weekend Masses and liturgical celebrations.

LECTORS: All men, women, and high school students are invited to proclaim the Scriptures at Mass.

ALTAR SERVING: All boys and girls of the parish who have completed the third grade are invited to serve as acolytes for weekend liturgies and special liturgical celebrations.

HOSPITALITY TEAM:

These ministers help create a culture and spirit of hospitality, while also ensuring the liturgy flows smoothly.

MUSIC MINISTRY:

We welcome singers and a variety of instrumentalists to lead us in singing God's praises at worship.



SACRAMENTAL LIFE AT OLS

BAPTISM: First time parents are asked to attend a pre-Baptismal class, available by appointment at the Parish Center.

EUCCHARIST: This joyful celebration takes place each year as young girls and boys are welcomed into the full community of faith at our Parish.

CONFIRMATION: A yearly journey of all 8th graders who have been enrolled in our Religious Education program for at least 2 years, or attend Catholic School.

MARRIAGE: Contact the Parish Center at least 6 months in advance of your desired wedding date so preparations can be made for your celebration.

ANNOINTING OF THE SICK: If a member of your family has become sick or hospitalized, please contact us.

VISITATION OF THE SICK: Any parishioner who is homebound and would like to regularly receive the Eucharist may contact the Parish Center to schedule a visit.

FUNERALS: Please notify the Parish Center at the time of your loved one's death so that we may assist in the planning of the funeral.

FOSTERING FAITH IN OUR YOUTH

YOUTH MINISTRY: This organization seeks to energize the youth of our linked parishes in strengthening a relationship with Jesus Christ.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: "Growing the Seeds of Faith" is the primary goal of our K-8 program, which includes sacramental preparation, cluster groups led by dedicated Catechists, and weekend classes at OLP School. Watch the bulletin for additional updates, and register your child on our website to enliven our community's next generation.

VBS: This fun and active way for children ages 4 - 9 to learn about God's love is offered in a week-long summer session, this year to be held from June 24 to 28. Visit www.olsparish.net/vbs to register.

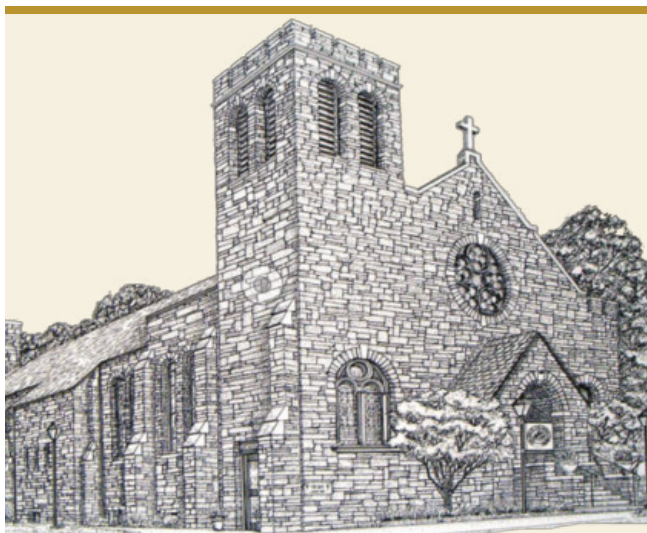
