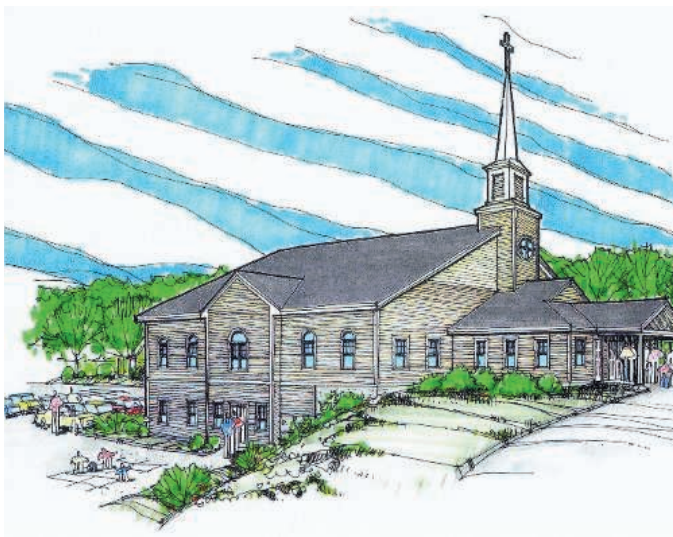

# 17<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time

July 28, 2019

*One of the lessons that God teaches us today is that negotiations are possible with Him. In today's reading from Genesis, the Prophet Abraham bargained with Him. He reasoned that in his day everyone was collectively responsible for evil in the community. The Lord in the Gospel continues that dialogue: it comes down to the fact that we also can negotiate. We ask to be forgiven in the measure that we forgive others. The Lord teaches us to present the case, to talk about it, and not necessarily accept the first answer. The bottom line of our relationship with God is "Your will be done" – but it comes after the negotiations are over. Perhaps this week would be a good time to evaluate our prayer life, both as an individual and a family.*
