

<u>New General Guidelines at St. Mary of Czestochowa Church</u> (Starting May 23 – Pentecost Sunday)

- 1. Masks are required to be worn by the faithful while inside the church and any church building (school, parish offices, etc.).
- 2. No social distancing will be required within the church. All pews will be available for seating.
- 3. Hymnals, Missals, Missalettes, etc. may be placed in pews.
- 4. Choirs and instrumentalists are allowed. The wearing of masks and social distancing for choirs and instrumentalists is recommended.
- 5. Congregational singing with masks is allowed.
- 6. Altar servers are allowed
- 7. Holy Communion is to be distributed by clergy (priests/deacons) ONLY
- 8. Masks are required by everyone in the sanctuary except the celebrant and anyone speaking to the congregation.
- 9. Collection baskets with handles passed by ushers are permitted.
- 10. The offertory procession is permitted.

Sunday Obligation

The general dispensation from attendance at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation will be ended as of this weekend Sunday, May 23, 2021-the Solemnity of Pentecost.

Given the reality that the pandemic has not completely subsided, some persons may be prevented from attending Mass for legitimate reasons, including:

- 1. Those suffering from serious pre-existing conditions that may make them more susceptible to falling ill from COVID-19;
- 2. Those who are ill and homebound;
- 3. a caregiver in close contact with someone who:

A. has tested positive for any contagious disease, including COVID-19

B. is in quarantine due to exposure to any contagion or residing with someone who is in quarantine

CALVARY CEMETERY REMINDERS

Planting season will begin soon. Planting and decorating rules are posted at the cemetery and on our website, **www.stmarymiddletown.com**. Here are some quick tips to keep your plot in compliance.

- No perennial bushes (including rose, peony, etc.), shrubs or vines.
- No balloons
- No placement of any plants or decorations on footstones. Please keep items on the headstone area.
- Maximum of 3 items of decoration, including lights.
- No edging

In addition, the area designated as the Memorial Section where there are only footstones, has special requirements. The area is to be decoration free, EXCEPT for 5 days prior and after national and religious holidays. There are posted rules in this area as well. Explanation for these rules is posted on our website.

Primarily, we want to have a respectful, Catholic cemetery that is clean and maintained appropriately. We also need to understand that the mowers cannot get off their equipment to move flowers and decorations. Thank you for your cooperation.
