*Catechism Stop*

Question: What is the Catholic Churches stance on Organ donation? Is this allowed/encouraged?

Answer: Yes, organ donation is allowed and encouraged by the Catholic church. It is in line with the churches position on respecting and defending all life from birth to natural death. The Catechism of the Catholic church fully address this issue in No. 2296, which reads "Organ transplants are in conformity with the moral law if the physical and psychological dangers and risks to the donor are proportionate to the good sought for the recipient. Organ donation after death is a noble and meritorious act and is to be encouraged as a expression of generous solidarity. It is not morally acceptable if the donor or his proxy has not given explicit consent. Moreover, it is not morally admissible to bring about the disabling mutilation or death of a human being, even in order to delay the death of other persons."
