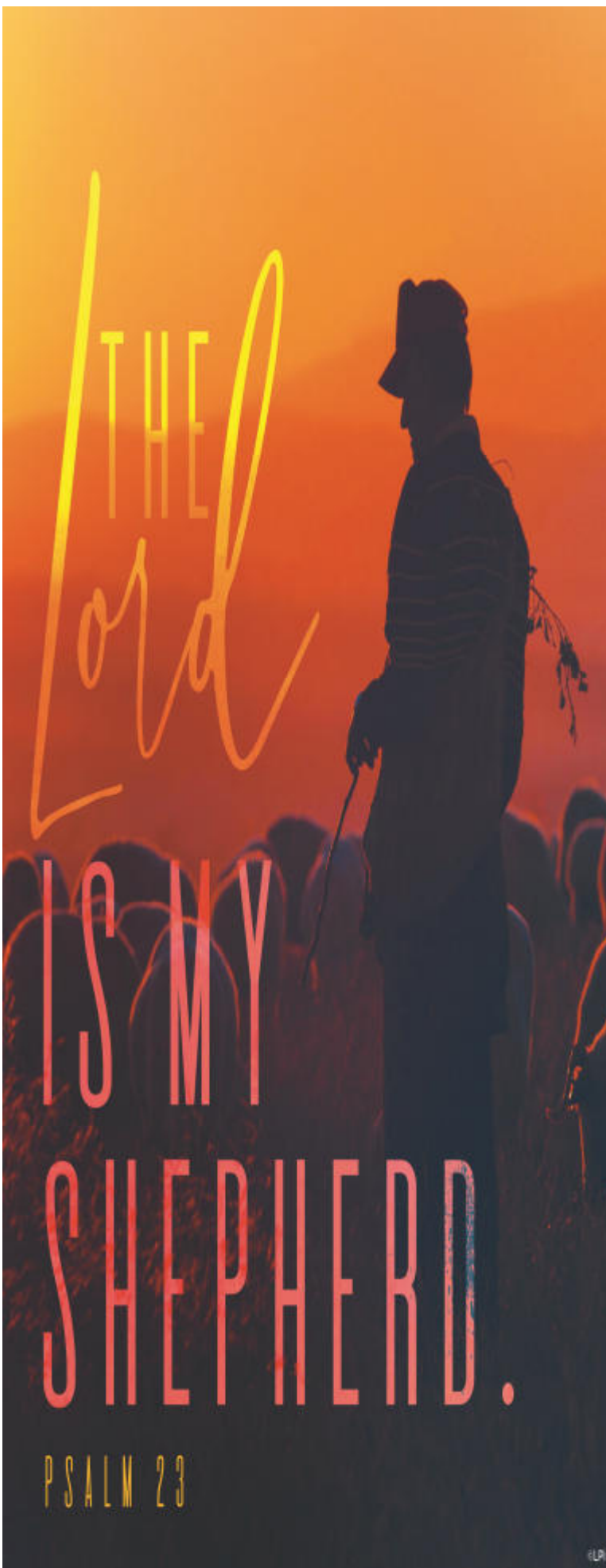

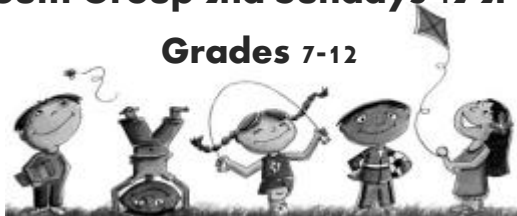

**Catechism Stop**

Question: Why do we give up things for Lent?

Answer: The origin of Lent comes from the 40 days that Jesus spent in the desert, prior to his public ministry, that were spent fasting and in prayer. The purpose of Lent is for us to have a connection to the suffering that Jesus endured and to draw us closer to God. So how does giving up chocolate or my favorite T.V. show draw me closer to God? Good question. If you cannot answer that question for yourself, then maybe you need to look at another sacrifice. If however, you give up chocolate, and every time you during Lent you think about having a some chocolate you offer up a prayer for all those who go hungry, that would be an example of a good Lenten sacrifice. Or if you give up watching your favorite show and devote that time to prayer, now you are on to something. Just like many things in life, the key is found in the intention behind the action. It's not about giving up something just to give up something. It is about strengthening ones relationship with God and to look outside of ourselves and our own needs over this 40 day period.
