Catechism Stop

Question: What is a Valid Catholic?

Answer: A Valid Catholic is defined by the Church when it says that Catholic must and the minimum follow the precepts of the Catholic Church and these are;

- 1) Attend Mass on every Sunday and on Holy days of obligation and rest from servile labor on these days.
 - 2) Go to confession once per year (suggested during Easter season)
 - 3) Receive the Eucharist at least once a year (during the Easter Season).
 - 4) Observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church.
 - 5) Help to provide for the needs of the Church.
- These are what a Catholic must do at the minimum to be considered a valid Catholic.
