#### CATECHISM STOP

**Question:** How can we pray for the dead throughout the year? **Answer:** We commemorate the faithful departed on November 2<sup>nd</sup> each year. 

The stigma attached to suicide increase the anxiety and isolation we feel. Medical studies report that what suicide loss survivors find most helpful is "talking one-to-one with another survivor and participating in suicide grief support group." As companions we accompany each other in a setting where free expression of grief is acceptable, confidentiality is observed, and compassion and non-judgmental attitudes prevail as we encounter Divine Mercy.
