REFLECTION



We are all in need of a physician who can help us overcome the blind spots and failing of own sins, weaknesses, and ignorance. Like a gentle and skillful doctor, the Lord Jesus exposes the cancer of sin, evil, and oppression in our lives so we can be set free and restored to wholeness. A key step to healing and restoration requires that we first submit to the physician who can heal us. The Lord Jesus wants to heal and restore us to wholeness, not only for our own sake alone. He also wants us to be his instruments of healing, pardon, and restoration for others as well. How easy it is to misjudge others and how difficult it is to be impartial in giving good judgment. Our judgment of others is usually "off the mark" because we can't see inside the other person, or we don't have access to all the facts, or we are swayed by instinct and unreasoning reactions to people. It is easier to find fault in others than in oneself. A critical and judgmental spirit crushes rather than heals, oppresses rather than restores. "Thinking the best of other people" is necessary if we wish to grow in love. "*What you give to others (and how you treat others) will return to you*" (Mk 4:24).

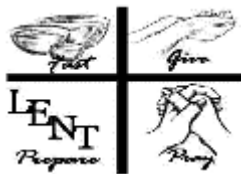
Please consider donating **scratch tickets** of any denomination for our Easter Lottery Tree. Please place them in the collection basket after Mass by **March 3rd**.

GUIDELINES FOR FAST AND ABSTINENCE

Lenten fast and abstinence regulations for the Diocese of Worcester are as follows: Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics four-

teen (14) years of age and older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent. Fasting is to be observed by all Catholics who are eighteen (18) years of age but not yet fifty-nine (59) years of age on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound to fast may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed Lenten penitential practices.

REFLEKSJA



Pewne stare hinduskie opowiadanie mówi o tym, że jeden z uczniów dopuścił się straszego występku. Jego koledzy go potępili, tymczasem nauczyciel milczał i w ogóle nie zareagował. Wreszcie uczniowie zgodnie wybuchli złością, twierdząc, że nie może dłużej udawać, że nic się nie wydarzyło. Krzyknęli: „Bóg dał ci oczy!”. Wtedy Nauczyciel odrzekł: „Tak, to prawda dał mi

oczy, ale dał mi też powieki”. Sługa Boży ks. Franciszek Jordan umieścił w swoim *Dzienniku duchowym* taką myśl: „Człowiek pokorny wyznaje swoją winę i słabość, człowiek pyszny stara się ją ukryć w brudzie innych”. Czasami krytykujemy innych i upominamy ich, aby odwrócić uwagę od naszych błędów i potknięć.

Ktoś powiedział, że jeśli stoi się w błocie po kolana, to najlepiej pochłapać tym błotem innych, aby nie zauważyli przypadkiem, że chlapiący jest w błocie, tylko patrzyli na siebie nawzajem. Zanim jednak przystąpisz do upominania innych, nie zapomnij, że najpierw sam masz być dla nich wzorem i naprawić własne błędy. Do upomnienia ma prawo ten, kto sam jest bez zarzutu. Nie masz prawa zwracać uwagi synowi, córce, że przeklina, jeśli sam jesteś wulgarny. Nie masz prawa upominać dziecka, gdy ono kradnie, jeśli sam wynosisz coś z zakładu pracy.

Nie masz prawa upomnieć kogoś, że pije, jeśli sam pijesz. Upomnieć trzeba najpierw samego siebie, a potem to upomnienie wcielić w życie. Co jest warunkiem skutecznego upomnienia? Święty Paweł odpowiada – miłość! Jeśli twoje serce będzie pełne dobra, wtedy będziesz mógł z większą skutecznością pomóc innym. Bo kiedy w twoim sercu jest zło, coś dobrego możesz innym przekazać?
