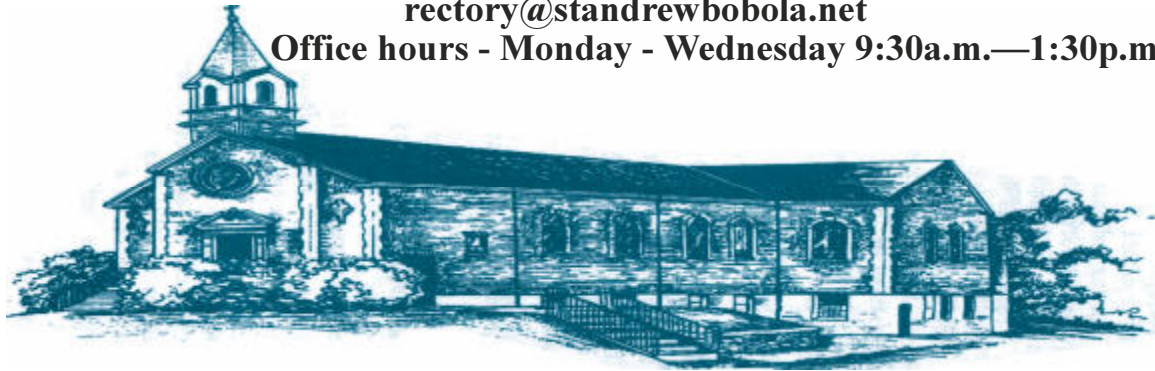

3 Sunday of Easter – May 5, 2019

“Peter was distressed that Jesus had said to him a third time, ‘Do you love me?’ and he said to him, ‘Lord, you know everything; you know that I love you.’ Jesus said to him, ‘Feed my sheep.’” (John 21:17)

REFLECTION



Why didn't the apostles immediately recognize the Lord Jesus when he greeted them at the Sea of Tiberias? John gives us a clue. Peter was discouraged and didn't know what to do after the tragedy of Jesus' death! He went back to his previous career out of despair and uncertainty. After the miraculous catch, Jesus told Peter that he would be 'catching people' for the kingdom of God. The Lord Jesus is ready to reveal himself to each one of us as we listen for his voice and open our hearts to receive his word. Do you recognize the Lord's presence in your life and do you receive his word with faith? Why did Jesus question Peter's love and loyalty three times in front of the other apostles? It must have caused Peter pain and sorrow since he had publicly denied Jesus three times. Now Peter, full of remorse and humility stated that he loved his Master and was willing to serve him whatever it might cost. The Lord Jesus calls each one of us, even in our own personal weakness and sin, to declare our loyalty to him that we love him first and foremost, above all else. Nothing but our own sinful pride and stubborn willfulness can keep us from the love of God. He loved us first and our love for him is a response to his exceeding graciousness and mercy.

One of the Catholic practices is the dedication of May as the month of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

May crownings and other special events in May in honor of Mary, such as public recitation of the rosary and singing of the Loreto Litany are communal events.

In our parish, in this beautiful month of Mary, we will have our devotions in Honor of the Blessed Mother every Sunday at 9:00 am and during weekly Masses, **On May 11th at 4 pm we will have a ceremony of the crowning of the statue of the Blessed Mother**. The Coronation of Mary sets Mary up as your Queen who distributes many gifts, especially the gift of peace. It is helpful to look at a picture of the Coronation of Mary which is the last of the Glorious Mysteries of the Rosary, when Mary, Mother of Jesus was crowned queen of heaven and earth. Keep these events in mind as well as the fruit of the mystery which is trust in Mary's intercession as you pray the Rosary.

REFLEKSJA



Trudne pytanie postawił Jezus Piotrowi - „Czy miłujesz Mnie więcej aniżeli ci?” Obok stał Jan, jedyny, który nie zawiódł Mistrza w Wielki Piątek i odważnie stanął blisko krzyża. Udowodnił wtedy, że kocha więcej niż pozostali Apostołowie, więcej niż Piotr. Ten bowiem w chwili krzyżowania Jezusa, w ukryciu, łzami zmywał trzykrotne zaparcie się Mistrza na dziedzińcu pałacu Kajfasza. Teraz Piotr doświadczył przebaczącej miłości Chrystusa. Zgrzeszył, i ciężko, żałował, a Jezus mu przebaczył. Grzech bowiem głęboko rani serce, a jeśli w akcie żalu człowiek sam otworzy tę ranę przed Bogiem, Ten wlewa w nią swą przebaczącą miłość. Człowiek wówczas odkrywa zbawczy wymiar miłości. Jezus przez długi czas wychowywał Piotra do tego, by był opoką Kościoła. Chciał mieć pewność, że nie zawiedzie, że potrafi znaleźć właściwe rozwiązanie nawet w momentach tak dramatycznych jak grzech. Trzykrotnie więc pyta o miłość. Tylko ten bowiem, kto naprawdę kocha, nie zawiedzie, a jeśli zawiedzie, potrafi to naprawić. Od tej rozmowy z Chrystusem życie Piotra zamienia się w ustawiczne wyznanie miłości. Składał jej dowody przez długie lata, aż nadszedł dzień męczeńskiej śmierci na Watykańskim Wzgórzu. Ostatnie wyznanie miłości złożył, jak Mistrz — na krzyżu. Droga Piotra od grzechu do wyznania miłości jest dla nas pełna nadziei. Nawet zaparcie się Boga może być zmyte aktem prawdziwej miłości. Nie należy po grzechu rozrywać szat, lecz otworzyć serce aktem prawdziwego żalu, by umożliwić Bogu wlanie weń przebaczącej miłości. Tak niewiele potrzeba, by nawet po najcięższych grzechach zobaczyć nad sobą pochyloną twarz kochającego Ojca

KORONACJA MATKI BOŻEJ



Rozpoczynamy miesiąc Maryjny poświęcony Matce Bożej, która nie pozostaje nigdy głucha na wołanie i płacz swoich dzieci. Zawsze cierpliwie wysłuchuje ich, by przez swoje wstawiennictwo i orędownictwo wyjednać u Chrystusa łaskę zmiłowania. We wszystkich kościołach, przy przydrożnym krzyżu, kapliczce wierni wyśpiewują swojej Matce Litanie Loretańską. Tam, gdzie sklepieniem jest niebo, a organami – majowy wiatr i ptasi wtór, najłatwiej jest otworzyć się przed Matką, „u której serce otwarte każdemu”. Śpiewając Litanie Loretańską wzywamy Matkę Bożą o pomoc szczególnie w czasach obecnych, gdy nasza wiara tak często wystawiana jest na próbę różnorodnych pokus, gdy jej fundamenty podkopywane są przez wrogów Kościoła, gdy człowieka dosięga zwątpienie i rozpacz. Nabożeństwo Majowe to spotkanie z Matką Boga i z Jej Synem. To możliwość zawierzenia Jej całej swojej życiowej codzienności, problemów i pogmatwanych dróg. Trzeba tylko pójść do Niej, opowiedzieć Jej o tym, zaufać Jej w każdej sprawie. Na pewno zawsze przytuli do swojego Serca, pośpieszy z pomocą, wyprowadzi na właściwą drogę. Polecajmy jej opiece nasze rodziny, naszą parafię, ludzi chorych i samotnych, dzieci i młodzież.
