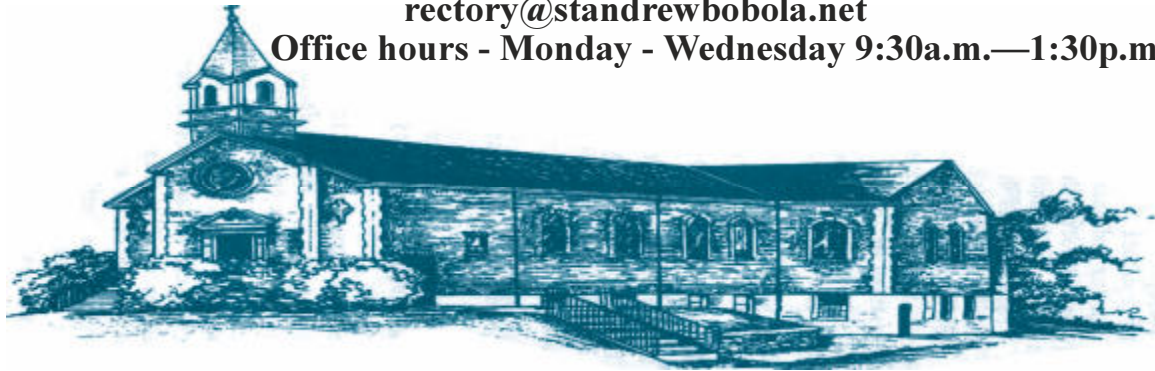

**REFLECTION**

How can we love one another as Christ has loved us? Jesus poured out his Holy Spirit on his disciples at Pentecost and he pours out his Spirit today on all who believe in him. If we yield our hearts to Jesus

and submit to his will for us, then the Holy Spirit will purify all that is unloving, unkind, and unforgiving in us. This is the power that overcomes the world - the triumphant cross of Christ which breaks the destructive forces of sin, hatred, and division. And we share in the power of Christ's victory by embracing the cross which the Lord Jesus sets before each one of us. What is the cross that I must take up daily in order to follow the Lord Jesus? When my will crosses with God's will, then his will must be done. The cross of Christ sets us free to live no longer for ourselves but for Christ and his kingdom of peace, joy, and righteousness. Our calling and privilege is to serve as Christ has served and to love and he has loved. That is the way we share in the glory of our heavenly Father who gave us his beloved Son who laid down his life for each one of us. The distinctive mark of every disciple and follower of Jesus Christ is love - a love that is ready to forgive and forget past injuries, to heal and restore rather than inflict revenge and injury. The cross of Jesus is the only way to pardon, peace, forgiveness, and reconciliation. Every other way will fail or fall short of the glory and victory which Jesus Christ has won for us through his death and resurrection. If we embrace his love and truth and allow his Holy Spirit to purify and transform our hearts and minds, then we will find the inner freedom, joy, and strength we need to love without measure, to forgive without limit, and to serve without reward.

**REFLEKSJA**

Jako chrześcijanie doskonale wiemy, że istnieje ogromne zapotrzebowanie w świecie na wzajemną miłość. Przypomina nam o tym Jezus w Wieczerniku, dając nowe prawo – prawo miłości, które jest znakiem rozpoznawczym Jego uczniów: „Daję wam przykazanie

nowe, abyście się wzajemnie miłowali, tak jak Ja was umiłowalem; żebyście i wy tak się miłowali wzajemnie. Po tym wszyscy poznają, żeście uczniami moimi, jeśli będziecie się wzajemnie miłowali”. Chrześcijańska miłość bliźniego jest nie tylko znakiem rozpoznawczym, ale także znakiem jedności we wspólnocie wierzących. Człowiek stworzony na obraz i podobieństwo Boże nie może bowiem w pełni zrealizować samego siebie inaczej jak tylko poprzez miłość, czyli przez bezinteresowny, szczerzy dar z samego siebie, ze swojego życia. Bez wzajemnej miłości trudno sobie wyobrazić normalne funkcjonowanie w domu, w pracy, na ulicy czy w parafii. Dlatego często szukamy miłości wokół siebie. Nie czekajmy z naszym wyrażaniem miłości, aż będzie za późno. Oto słowa Gabriela Marqueza, laureata literackiej Nagrody Nobla, chorego na nowotwór złośliwy układu limfatycznego. Tak napisał w liście do swoich przyjaciół: „Jutro nie jest zagwarantowane nikomu, ani młodemu, ani staremu. Być może, że dzisiaj patrzysz po raz ostatni na tych, których kochasz. Dlatego nie zwlekaj, uczyni to dzisiaj, bo jeśli się okaże, że nie doczekasz jutra, będziesz żałował dnia, w którym zabrakło ci czasu na jeden uśmiech, na jeden pocałunek, że byłeś zbyt zajęty, by przekazać im ostatnie życzenie. Bądź zawsze blisko tych, których kochasz, mów im głośno, jak bardzo ich potrzebujesz, jak ich kochasz i bądź dla nich dobry, miej czas, aby im powiedzieć -‘przepraszam’, ‘proszę’, ‘dziękuję’ i wszystkie inne słowa miłości, jakie znasz. Nikt cię nie będzie pamiętał za twoje myśli sekretne. Proś Pana o siłę i mądrość, abyś mógł je wyrazić.
