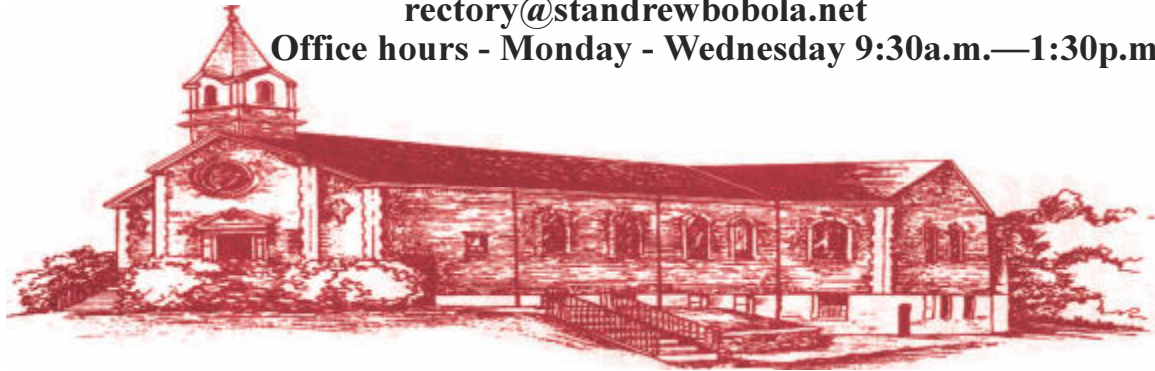

**REFLECTION**

In the gospel today we hear Jesus appearing to his fearful disciples after his resurrection. These fearful men are locked in a room. Their

faith and trust in Jesus seems to have disappeared. Now he comes into their midst and offers them peace and joy. The opposite of faith is not lack of faith but rather fear. We try to rely on ourselves only and as a result may feel incapable of responding to what God is asking of us. So when Jesus appears to them in today's gospel he breathes on them and says 'Receive the Holy Spirit'. This recalls the first creation when God breathed life into Adam, transforming him from dust into a human being. Here we have a new creation, now enlivened by the Spirit. This is a new transformation. If we offer our lives to the Holy Spirit for transformation, we will find that we will gradually be changed, not just spiritually but on other levels too, emotionally, psychologically. The Spirit wants to do this for us because Jesus tells the disciples today that as the Father sent Jesus, he is sending them to be his witnesses. Christian witness comes from an inner conviction. This is only achieved by spending time with Jesus in prayer regularly. People will know a real witness because he or she speaks from personal conviction. And Christian witness has to end in outward testimony; a person who is prepared to say and live by what he believes to be true. It is impossible to achieve our call to witness to Jesus without the powerful Holy Spirit who so much wants to help us. Jesus then tells the disciples after breathing on them the Holy Spirit: 'Those whose sins you forgive, they are forgiven, those whose sins you retain, they are retained'. In the 'Our Father' in Matthew's gospel chapter 6, forgiveness is the only quality that has a condition attached to it – 'forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us'. Today's feast is telling us clearly that the Spirit works powerfully still in many different ways and in many different peoples. We are sent as witnesses, proclaiming and living forgiveness. Difficult as this is, it has to be a central part of our witness. Let us pray often for the help of the Spirit. "Come Holy Spirit, renew each of us so that we can work together to renew the face of the earth. Amen".

**Feast of Corpus Christi**

Corpus Christi (Boże Ciało) will soon be upon us. We have been invited to join with St. Joseph's Basilica in their procession. In order to maintain this tradition in our parish, we will need volunteers to construct/assemble the outdoors altars for this event on June 23. If you or your family will take responsibility for one of the 4 altars, please let Father Chris or the Rectory know by June 11. If we do not have enough volunteers who will be responsible for the altars to carry on this tradition at St. Andrew's, we will join with St. Joseph's.

**PODZIĘKOWANIE DLA KS. PRAŁATA**

W związku z planowanym w lipcu przejściem Ks. Prałata na emeryturę, w sobotę, 22 czerwca, w centrum parafialnym odbędzie się pożegnalna kolacja, na której będziemy mieli możliwość osobistego podziękowania Ks. Prałatowi za Jego posługę w naszej wspólnotce przez ponad 25 lat. Uroczystość nie będzie biletowana, jednak prosimy o zgłaszanie swojego udziału w biurze parafialnym celem przygotowania spotkania na odpowiednią liczbę gości.

**REFLEKSJA**

Różnimy się między sobą, ale Bóg nas łączy. Jedność w Kościele jest skomponowana z naszej różnorodności. Bez Bożego ognia miłości nasza jedność stałaby się początkiem niechęci i wzajemnych oskarżeń. Bóg dał Apostołom moc do przebaczenia i jednania się, ponieważ trwali na jednym miejscu. Gdy po raz pierwszy Jezus tchnął w nich Ducha, aby byli zdolni odpuszczać grzechy, stało się to tam, gdzie przebywali razem. Bez Boga nie potrafimy sobie przebaczać, trwać w jedności mimo różnic. Kościół jest nam potrzebny, abyśmy mogli doświadczać pomocy Ducha Świętego, by ciągle sobie przebaczać i kochać się wzajemnie, mimo różnorodności. Duch przychodzi, gdy wydaje się, że tracimy Jezusa. Duch Święty przyszedł do uczniów wtedy, gdy Jezus miał za sobą Golgotę i gdy wstąpił do nieba. Uczniom pozostała już tylko modlitwa. Drzwi były zamknięte z lęku przed ludźmi, przed represjami. Zamknięte drzwi to wymowny obraz odcięcia się od wszystkich, zawiedzenia się na życiu, rezygnacji z wychodzenia innym naprzeciw, wycofania. Gdy wojska wycofują się z frontu, wiadomo, że oznacza to klęskę. Wycofujemy się, gdy przeżyliśmy porażkę. Zamykamy drzwi, gdy chcemy uciec, bo wszyscy nas ranią. Zamknięte drzwi to zamknięty w sobie człowiek, który już nie wierzy w to, że cokolwiek w życiu mu się uda. Z lęku zamykamy się w sobie i stajemy się niedostępni jak wierzchołek skały. Nikomu nie pozwalamy się zbliżyć do siebie. Właśnie wtedy przybywa Duch Święty z pomocą, którą jest On sam! Ptaki przecież siadają na wierzchołkach gór, na niedostępnych miejscach! Jak gołębie układają gniazda z połamanych gałązek, tak Duch Święty bierze pod swoje skrzydła ludzi połamanych zwątpieniem, złamanym bólem – czyni w nich swoje gniazdo.

**Procesja Bożego**

Ciała Zbliża się Uroczystość Bożego Ciała 23 czerwca. Zostaliśmy zaproszeni przez parafie św. Józefa, aby razem celebrować Uroczystość z udziałem we wspólnej procesji ulicami Webster. Zanim podejmiemy decyzję, pragnę poprosić parafian, aby odpowiedzieli mi kto będzie odpowiedzialny za przygotowanie 4 ołtarzy w naszej parafii. Proszę powiadomić kancelarię parafialną lub osobiście ks. Proboszcza, kto przygotowuje każdy ołtarz i udekoruje kwiatami. Jeżeli nie znajdą się chętni, aby przygotować ołtarze w naszej parafii, wtedy dołączymy do wspólnej celebracji z parafią św. Józefa.
