Legacy of Hope Campaign, Diocese of Worcester:

Our Partner's in Charity Appeal will continue through March 15th. Thank you to all that have already contributed for your generosity. We hope to reach or even exceed our goal as we did last year.

Following this appeal, St. Andrew Bobola Parish will hold the Legacy of Hope Capital Campaign, which is being conducted by every parish in the Diocese of Worcester.

At St. Andrew Bobola, Legacy of Hope will run from March 20th through June 30th.

Legacy of Hope is intended to address Individual Parish Needs, Priest Retirement and Custodial Care, Catholic Education, Parish-Based Charitable Outreach, Parish-Based Evangelization and Structural Repairs for the Cathedral of St. Paul.

The target goal for St. Andrew Bobola Parish, to be collected over a 4 year period, is \$157,381. 40% of every dollar raised up to the goal will come back to our parish with 60% going to the Diocese of Worcester.

Parishes will receive 60% of the funds raised over our assigned goal. Pledges can be filled on a monthly, quarterly, semiannual or annual basis. As a parish, we need to decide what our 40% share, or \$62,952, will be used for.

While members of the Parish Counsel and Finance Committee have discussed possible projects or needs in the parish, we want to hear from you for your ideas.

We ask that over the next two weeks, you write your ideas or suggestions on a piece of paper labeled Legacy of Hope and place this in the Weekly Collection Basket. Ideas can be signed or anonymous. Here are some ideas that have been discussed. You can let us know if you like these, or if you would like to see something else.

Possible parish needs to be funded by Legacy of Hope:

* Electronic message board to replace the sign in front of the rectory. This would be a double sided, waterproof, color digital video screen that would be used to announce parish events like bake sales, yard sales, Mass times, special celebrations or other events. The cost for a good quality version would be approximately \$30,000.

* Replace or tune the organ. The organ system is dated and the sound quality and functionality is lacking. A used organ from another church could cost \$10,000. Having the organ professionally tuned and restored would be less expensive. * Refurbish the church hall. We make use of our church hall for Lent Fish Dinners and other social gatherings and events, especially given that we have a newly renovated kitchen and repeated food sales as well as CCD class and other uses for this large space. The hall can be improved with a drop ceiling, updated walls, floor, paint, audio/video capabilities, etc... The cost can vary widely, depending on what work we would have done. Such a project could help to make our parish more attractive to the general public for various dinners, dances, social and religious gatherings and events like wedding or funeral receptions. While this activity has been scaled back due to the pandemic, we seek to plan for the future. * Replace the church/rectory roof. While we have had spot roof repairs, this is not a long-term solution. The church has roof will need replaced experienced water leaks and the to be in the next few vears. * HVAC maintenance. Every year, especially in the summer, we experience problems with the air conditioning/heating system that require costly maintenance or updates. We can expect that a few thousand dollars may be needed over the next couple of years to address our dated heating and air conditioning system.

* Elevator maintenance. Similar to keeping our HVAC system properly running, we have costs associated with doing the same for the elevator. Again, this can cost a few thousand dollars.

* General maintenance fund. A certain amount of money, or percentage, raised by the parish during this capital campaign can be set aside as part of a general fund. Our weekly collections should be used to cover our month-to-month operating costs, but unexpected costs to make repairs in the church or rectory can arise. For instance, an electrician may be needed if we have another power surge from an electrical storm.

* A new sound system in the church. The audio system in the church can be improved.

Some parishes in the diocese have plans for new flooring, parking lot lines/sealing, etc..

What does St. Andrew Bobola Parish need?

How would you like the parish to use the funds collected from Legacy of Hope (our 40%, up to \$62,952 if we hit our target)? We want to hear from you for your ideas. Please drop your suggestion(s) in the collection basket over the next two weeks. You can also speak with members of the Parish Counsel, Finance Committee and our Pastor. All ideas will be considered and then decided upon before the Legacy of Hope Capital Campaign begins in our parish. Once a case or need for the parish funds are established, all money raised will be used only for that purpose or those particular items.
