

#### Calendar Raffle Report and Update

As a result, the \$4200 made from the sale of the calendars is 100% profit!!! This money stays in St. Andrew Bobola Parish and will be put to good use to defray expenses incurred by the parish over the winter and the months ahead.

Additional gratitude goes out to several winners who donated their winnings back to the parish: Weronika Mroczka, Daniel, Bugajski, Frak Lukaszek, Sallie Guske, Diane Slawniak -Your generosity is greatly appreciated!

Feedback regarding this fundraiser was very positive, including inquiries as to when we would hold this fundraiser again. With this in mind, we will be running another Calendar Raffle in the month of April. All Parishioners have been mailed raffle calendars for the month of April. Please buy or sell the 4 calendars that have been provided to you. Anyone who buys a calendar will have 30 opportunities to win in the month of April. We have prizes totaling \$1775 (all donated) and the last week in April is a big one – each day's drawing is \$100 or more!! The bottom of the calendar is perforated, making it easy for you to tear off and make your returns (along with the money) to the Rectory or in the weekly collection basket by April 1 so that all entries are included in the 30 days of drawings. #### Legacy of Hope Campaign, Diocese of Worcester:

Our Partner's in Charity Appeal will continue through March 15th. Thank you to all that have already contributed for your generosity. We hope to reach or even exceed our goal as we did last year.

Following this appeal, St. Andrew Bobola Parish will hold the Legacy of Hope Capital Campaign, which is being conducted by every parish in the Diocese of Worcester.

#### At St. Andrew Bobola, Legacy of Hope will run from March 20th through June 30th.

Legacy of Hope is intended to address Individual Parish Needs, Priest Retirement and Custodial Care, Catholic Education, Parish-Based Charitable Outreach, Parish-Based Evangelization and Structural Repairs for the Cathedral of St. Paul.

The target goal for St. Andrew Bobola Parish, to be collected over a 4 year period, is \$157,381. 40% of every dollar raised up to the goal will come back to our parish with 60% going to the Diocese of Worcester.

Parishes will receive 60% of the funds raised over our assigned goal. Pledges can be filled on a monthly, quarterly, semi-annual or annual basis. As a parish, we need to decide what our 40% share, or \$62,952, will be used for.

While members of the Parish Counsel and Finance Committee have discussed possible projects or needs in the parish, we want to hear from you for your ideas.

We ask that over the next two weeks, you write your ideas or suggestions on a piece of paper labeled Legacy of Hope and place this in the Weekly Collection Basket. Ideas can be signed or anonymous. Here are some ideas that have been discussed. You can let us know if you like these, or if you would like to see something else.

Possible parish needs to be funded by Legacy of Hope:

- \*Electronic message board to replace the sign in front of the rectory. This would be a double sided, waterproof, color digital video screen that would be used to announce parish events like bake sales, yard sales, Mass times.
- \*Replace or tune the organ. The organ system is dated and the sound quality and functionality is lacking. A used organ from another church could cost \$10,000. Having the organ professionally tuned and restored would be less expensive.
- \* Refurbish the church hall. The hall can be improved with a drop ceiling, updated walls, floor, paint, audio/video capabilities, etc... The cost can vary widely, depending on what work we would have done. Such a project could help to make our parish more attractive to the general public for various dinners, dances, social and religious gatherings and events like wedding or funeral receptions.
- \*Replace the church/rectory roof. While we have had spot roof repairs, this is not a long-term solution. The church has experienced water leaks and the roof will need to be replaced in the next few years. \* HVAC maintenance. Every year, especially in the summer, we experience problems with the air conditioning/heating

system that require costly maintenance or updates.

- \* Elevator maintenance. Similar to keeping our HVAC system properly running, we have costs associated with doing the same for the elevator. Again, this can cost a few thousand dollars.
- \*General maintenance fund. A certain amount of money, or percentage, raised by the parish during this capital campaign can be set aside as part of a general fund. Our weekly collections should be used to cover our month-to-month operating costs, but unexpected costs to make repairs in the church or rectory can arise.
- \* A new sound system in the church. The audio system in the church can be improved.

#### What does St. Andrew Bobola Parish need?

How would you like the parish to use the funds collected from Legacy of Hope (our 40%, up to \$62,952 if we hit our target)? We want to hear from you for your ideas. Please drop your suggestion(s) in the collection basket over the next two weeks. You can also speak with members of the Parish Counsel, Finance Committee and our Pastor.

Once a case or need for the parish funds are established, all money raised will be used only for that purpose or those **Please contact David Bugajski at 508-461-7361** if you are interested in assisting or if with any questions or concerns.
