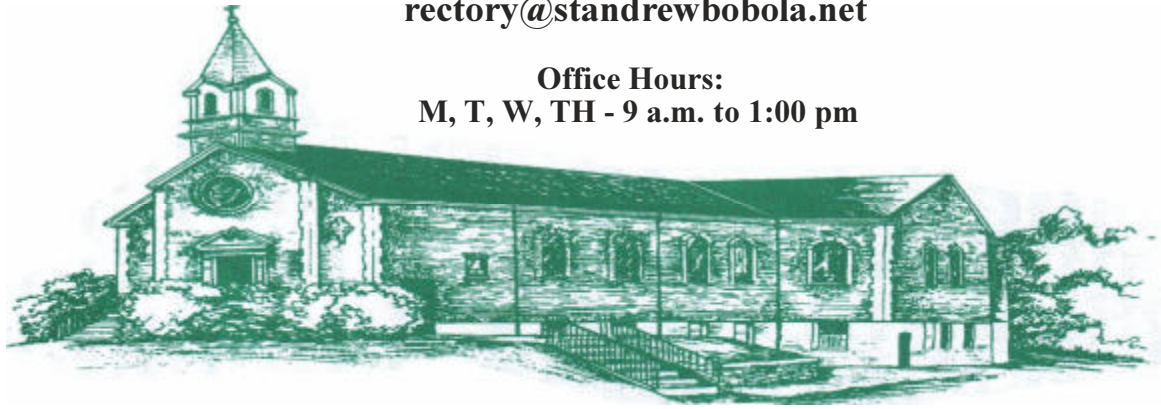

The Chaplet of Divine Mercy and Confession

*“Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them,
'Peace be with you.'” (John 20:19)*

In a place where people were fearful and grieving, Jesus comes with greetings of peace. His message of peace is a refrain throughout the entire gospel passage. First, he greets the disciples who are fearfully hiding with peace. Then, he greets the doubtful Thomas with peace. His followers needed this message. They needed calm in their state of darkness. This Sunday we observe Divine Mercy Sunday. It is an invitation to reflect on the many ways our world longs for God's mercy. It might be those who are in grief and full of anxiety, like the disciples in the gospel. It might be those in need of the corporal works of mercy. It might be those who are seeking healing. Whatever the need, we are called to reflect on how we can share Christ's peace with others through acts of mercy. God's mercy and love for us is enduring. Indeed, He sent his Son to bring us redemption, the ultimate act of mercy. Let us imitate Jesus' example of peace. Where there is fear, doubt, or any need for compassion, let us pray for the peace of Christ. **JESUS I TRUST IN YOU!!!**

CCD PROGRAM

There will be no CCD class on Sunday, April 4th (Easter) and Sunday April 18th (start of school vacation week).

A Confirmation Retreat will be held at Saint Andrew Bobola Church for all Confirmation candidates on Saturday, April 24th from 1pm to 5pm (including Mass at 4pm). There will be no CCD class for these Confirmation students the following day, Sunday, April 25th.

LEGACY OF HOPE

We are among 40 other parishes of the Diocese of Worcester who will participate in the Legacy of Hope Capital Campaign this Spring. The last similar campaign, called Forward in Faith, was conducted 20 years ago. With the success of Partners in Charity behind us, we look forward to **Legacy of Hope**. This is a \$32 Million Capital Campaign for the Diocese of Worcester that seeks to support Individual Parish Needs, Priest Retirement and Custodial Care, Catholic School Tuition Assistance, Parish-Based Charitable Outreach, Parish-Based Evangelization Initiatives and Structural Repairs/Renovation for the Cathedral of Saint Paul. The Campaign will run at Saint Andrew Bobola Parish from now through June 30th. The Overall Campaign Target for our parish is **\$157,381**, which is to be pledged and raised over a 4 year period. 40% of every dollar raised up to the Target amount (up to **\$62,952**) is returned to our parish and will be saved in a **General Maintenance Fund** for sudden or unexpected expenses, HVAC, plumbing, electrical, roofing and/or other church/rectory equipment. 60% of every dollar raised over the Target amount will be returned to our parish.

We are very pleased to report that leaders in our parish, including Father Chris and members of the Parish Council and Finance Committee, have already pledged a total of **\$39,400.00** toward the Legacy of Hope Campaign, over a period of 4 years. Thank you to all leaders who have stepped forward to be the first to commit their financial resources, including time, talent and treasure, to this campaign. This is an amazing sign of stewardship. Thank you for your generosity!

LEGACY OF HOPE

Nasza parafia św. Andrzeja Boboli jest wśród 40 parafii naszej decyzji, które rozpoczynają specjalny program - the Legacy of Hope Capital Campaign. Jest to wielkie wyzwanie dla wszystkich parafii diecezji, aby zebrać \$32 miliony, które będą zabezpieczeniem finansowym dla diecezji i które pozwolą utrzymać istniejące parafie i zostaną przeznaczone na różne potrzeby charytatywne i ewangelizacyjne: fundusz emerytalny dla księży naszej diecezji i ubezpieczenia, na utrzymanie szkół katolickich, prace remontowe naszej Katedry św. Pawła. Ten program rozpoczyna się wiosną i zakończy 30 czerwca. Każda parafia zobowiązana jest do zebrania wyznaczonej przez diecezję sumy. Nasza parafia proszona jest o zebranie **\$157,381** w ciągu 4 lat. 40% z tej zebranej sumy (to jest **\$62,952**) zostanie wpłacone na specjalne konto oszczędnościowe i użyte na generalne remonty kościoła i plebanii.

Z wielką radością pragnę poinformować naszych parafian, że na specjalnym zebraniu członkowie Rady Parafialnej i Finansowej wraz z ks. Proboszczem zadeklarowali przekazać na kampanię Legacy of Hope sumę **\$39,400** w ciągu 4 lat. Dziękujemy serdecznie wszystkim liderom naszej parafii za wspaniały przykład ofiarności i dobrego początku tej kampanii.

Nasza Parafia w czasie trwania tej kampanii planuje następujące spotkania z naszymi parafianami z przedstawicielami naszej diecezji Worcester, aby zapoznać ich bliżej ze szczegółami tej kampanii. Oto daty tych spotkań:

3. Sobota - Niedziela 22-23 maja prezentacja po mszy lidera Legacy of Hope - David Bugajski
4. Sobota- Niedziela 29-30 maja - prezentacja video na temat tej kampanii

Sobota- Niedziela 5-6 czerwca - specjalna kolektą na Legacy of Hope

Jest to dla mnie wielkim zaszczytem służyć pomocą dla tej kampanii Legacy of Hope jako jej przewodniczący. Dziękuję serdecznie wszystkim tym, którzy tworzą wraz ze mną specjalny Komitet pomagający prowadzić tą kampanię w naszej parafii: Paula Niksa, Dań Dering, Daniel Bugajski, Cathy Damien, oraz innym wolontariuszom.

THE YEAR OF ST. JOSEPH

Pope Francis in his apostolic letter, *Patris corde* ("With a Father's Heart"), proclaimed a year dedicated to Mary's husband, Joseph, foster father to Jesus. The occasion is the 150th anniversary of the declaration of St. Joseph as patron of the universal Church. The special "Year of St. Joseph" will be held through December 8, 2021. Plenary indulgence for the Year of St. Joseph A plenary indulgence is granted to the faithful under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion, and prayer for the Pope's intentions) to Christians who, with a spirit detached from any sin, participate in the Year of St. Joseph on these occasions and manners indicated by the Apostolic Penitentiary:

- A plenary indulgence is granted to those who will meditate for at least 30 minutes on the Lord's Prayer, or take part in a Spiritual Retreat of at least one day that includes a meditation on St. Joseph.
- An indulgence can also be obtained by those who, following St. Joseph's example, will perform a spiritual or corporal work of mercy.
- The recitation of the Holy Rosary in families and among engaged couples is another way of obtaining indulgences.
- Everyone who entrusts their daily activity to the protection of St. Joseph, and the faithful who invoke the intercession of St. Joseph so that those seeking work can find dignifying work can also obtain a plenary indulgence.
- A plenary indulgence is also granted to the faithful who recite the Litany to St. Joseph, or any other prayer to St. Joseph proper to the other liturgical traditions, for the persecuted Church and for the relief of all Christians suffering any form of persecution. In addition to these, the Apostolic Penitentiary grants a plenary indulgence to the faithful who will recite any legitimately approved prayer or act of piety in honor of St. Joseph, for example, "To you, O blessed Joseph" especially on March 19th, May 1st, the 19th of each month, and every Wednesday, a day dedicated to the memory of the saint according to the Latin tradition."

8 grudnia 2020 r. papież Franciszek ogłosił specjalny „Rok św. Józefa” z okazji 150. rocznicy ustanowienia Opiekuna Jezusa Patronem Kościoła powszechnego, który zakończy się 8 grudnia 2021 r. Udziela się Odpustu zupełnego pod zwykłymi

warunkami (tzn. sakramentalna spowiedź, Komunia eucharystyczna oraz modlitwa zgodna z intencjami Ojca Świętego) wiernym, którzy odrywając się w duchu od wszelkiego grzechu, uczestniczyć będą w Roku Świętego Józefa w okolicznościach i na sposoby określone przez tę Penitencjarię Apostolską. **Odpust zupełny można zyskać** (po wypełnieniu zwykłych warunków):

Za rozważanie słów modlitwy Ojcze nasz przez pół godziny, bądź za udział w dniu skupienia poświęconemu św. Józefowi.

Za spełnienie Uczynku miłosierdzia względem ciała bądź duszy.

Za wspólną modlitwę różańcową w rodzinie bądź pomiędzy narzeczonymi

Za powierzenie w modlitwie za przyczyną św. Józefa swojej pracy, bądź modlitwa w intencji osób bezrobotnych.

Za odmówienie Litanii do Świętego Józefa w intencji Kościoła prześladowanego oraz w intencji ulżenia wszystkim chrześcijanom, którzy cierpią prześladowania wszelkiego rodzaju,

Za odmówienie dowolnej zatwierdzonej modlitwy (np. z książeczki do modlitwy) do św. Józefa; szczególnie 19 marca, 1 maja, w Niedziele św. Rodziny, 19. dnia każdego miesiąca oraz w każdą środę.

Możliwość zyskania odpustu zupełnego została ponad to rozszerzona dla wszystkich, którzy nie mogą wypełnić zwykłych warunków zyskania odpustu: chorzy, osoby w podeszłym wieku, pozostające w izolacji, a którzy odrywając się w duchu od wszelkiego grzechu oraz z intencją wypełnienia, gdy tylko to będzie możliwe, zwykłych warunków, odmówią w domu lub tam, gdzie zatrzymuje ich przeszkoda, akt pobożności na cześć Świętego Józefa, pocieszyciela chorych i Patrona Dobrej Śmierci, ofiarując z ufnością Bogu boleści i niedogodności własnego życia.
