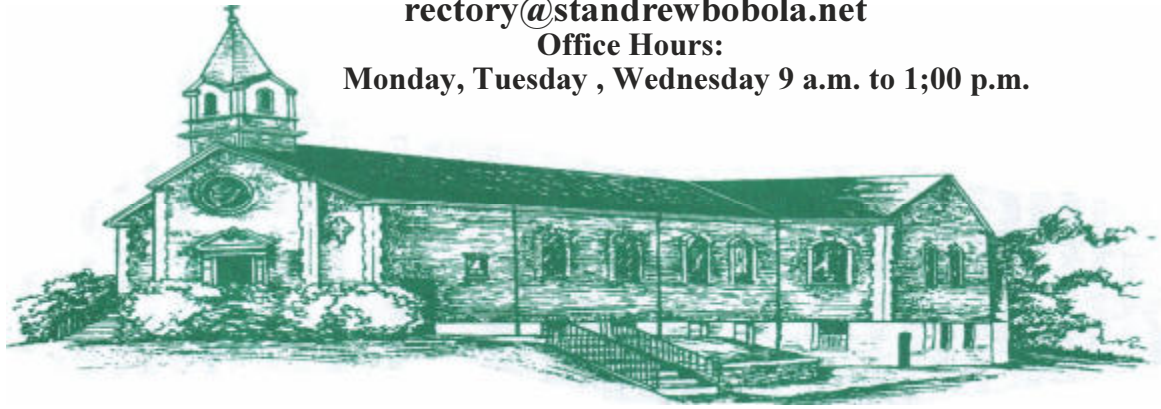

Ojciec Pio poświęcił się bez reszty konfesjonałowi. Spowiadał przez 52 lata. Nie był ani wybitnym kaznodzieją, ani znanym wychowawcą, ale mistrzem ludzkich sumień. Wielu mówiło, że każdego „widzi od środka”. By wypowiadać się, pielgrzymi z najdalszych zakątków świata czekali nawet dwa tygodnie. Wokół klasztoru rozbijali namioty albo spali pod gołym niebem. Otrzymywali numerki imienne i czekali na swoją kolej. Porządku pilnowali dyżurni .Oprócz nadzwyczajnych znaków, które nosił na swoim ciele, Ojciec Pio posiadał zdolność widzenia wnętrza duszy człowieka dzięki natchnieniom Boga. Ta zdolność objawiała się zwykle podczas spowiedzi. Często przypominał penitentom grzechy, których nie wyznali. Jeśli przeoczenie było niezamierzone i chodziło o grzechy powszednie, wszystko kończyło się dobrze. Jeśli natomiast ktoś celowo próbował ukryć swoje grzechy i jeśli chodziło o grzechy ciężkie, wówczas upomnienia Ojca Pio były gwałtowne, czasem przykre i niejednokrotnie zdarzało się, że taką osobę z hukiem odsyłał od konfesjonału. Ale również poza spowiedzią Ojciec Pio posiadał zdolność wewnętrznego rozeznania. Zdarzało się, że upominał na głos człowieka z tłumy albo cofał swoją rękę od kogoś, kto chciał ją ucałować, albo też pomijał osobę przy udzielaniu Komunii świętej. Zawsze była tego przyczyna, o czym wiedziała tylko osoba dotknięta. Relacje ludzi, których wypowiadał Ojciec Pio są bardzo podobne: był surowy i wymagający, a jednocześnie kochający jak prawdziwy ojciec. Jego konfesjonał był „katedrą miłosierdzia”.Codzienna Eucharystia sprawowana przez 58 lat była sensem jego życia. Wstawał w środku nocy, aby się do niej przygotować. Po jej zakończeniu długi czas spędzał na modlitwie dziękczynnej.To nie było zwykle sprawowanie obrzędu, lecz prawdziwa Ofiara. Wszyscy, którzy w niej uczestniczyli mieli wrażenie, jakby naprawdę szli na Golgotę i stali u stóp Krzyża. Na czole Ojca Pio pojawiały się kropelki potu, z oczu płynęły łzy. Najtrudniejszy był moment Przeistoczenia. Widok przebitych dłoni unoszących Hostię wzruszał wszystkich. „Świat mógłby istnieć bez słońca, lecz nie mógłby istnieć bez Mszy św.” – powiedział kiedyś Ojciec Pio. Święty Ojciec Pio modl się za nami !

CCD REGISTRATION FOR 2021/2022

We plan to resume our CCD program starting Sunday, October 17th for grades 1 through 10. This is the weekend following the Columbus Day Holiday on October 11th. Registration forms are now available in the church on the front altar rail where the bulletin is located. Please complete and return these forms with payment to our CCD Program Coordinator David Bugajski who can be reached at 508-461-7361 with any questions. Completed forms can also be left in the sacristy following Mass. Please put these in an envelope marked "CCD". The CCD Registration Fee is \$20 for the first child, \$10 for a second child and \$5 for a third child. CCD classes for all grades will be held on Sundays starting on October 17th. We will have Sunday Mass at 10:30am for CCD students and families. Immediately following this Mass, CCD classes will be held in the church and church hall until 12:00.

A schedule of the program year will be provided in the future. CCD classes will not be held on Christmas or Easter, or during school vacation weeks. We will review updated safety guidelines issued by the state, the CDC and the Diocese of Worcester concerning masking and social distancing. We will communicate any changes or updates before the start of the CCD program. We will keep you advised. We seek volunteers to assist with our CCD program. The three Archangels Michael, Gabriel and Raphael are the only angels named in Sacred Scripture and all three have important roles in the history of salvation. Saint Michael is the "Prince of the Heavenly Host," the leader of all the angels. His name is Hebrew for "Who is like God?" and was the battle cry of the good angels against Lucifer and his followers when they rebelled against God. He is mentioned four times in the Bible, in Daniel 10 and 12, in the letter of Jude, and in Revelation. Michael, whose forces cast down Lucifer and the evil spirits into Hell, is invoked for protection against Satan and all evil. Pope Leo XIII, in 1899, having had a prophetic vision of the evil that would be inflicted upon the Church and the world in the 20th century, instituted a prayer asking for Saint Michael's protection to be said at the end of every Mass. Christian tradition recognizes four offices of Saint Michael: (i) to fight against Satan (ii) to rescue the souls of the faithful from the power of the enemy, especially at the hour of death. (iii) to be the champion of God's people, (iv) to call away from earth and bring men's souls to judgment. "I am Gabriel, who stand before God." (Luke 1, 19) Saint Gabriel, whose name means "God's strength," is mentioned four times in the Bible. Most significant are Gabriel's two mentions in the New Testament: to announce the birth of John the Baptist to his father Zacharias, and the at Incarnation of the Word in the womb of Mary. Christian tradition suggests that it is he who appeared to St. Joseph and to the shepherds, and also that it was he who "strengthened" Jesus during his agony in the garden of Gethsemane. "I am the angel Raphael, one of the seven, who stand before the Lord" (Tob 12:15) Saint Raphael, whose name means "God has healed" because of his healing of Tobias' blindness in the Book of Tobit. Tobit is the only book in which he is mentioned. His office is generally accepted by tradition to be that of healing and acts of mercy. Raphael is also identified with the angel in John 5:1-4 who descended upon the pond and bestowed healing powers upon it so that the first to enter it after it moved would be healed of whatever infirmity he was suffering. **Holy Archangels pray for us !**
