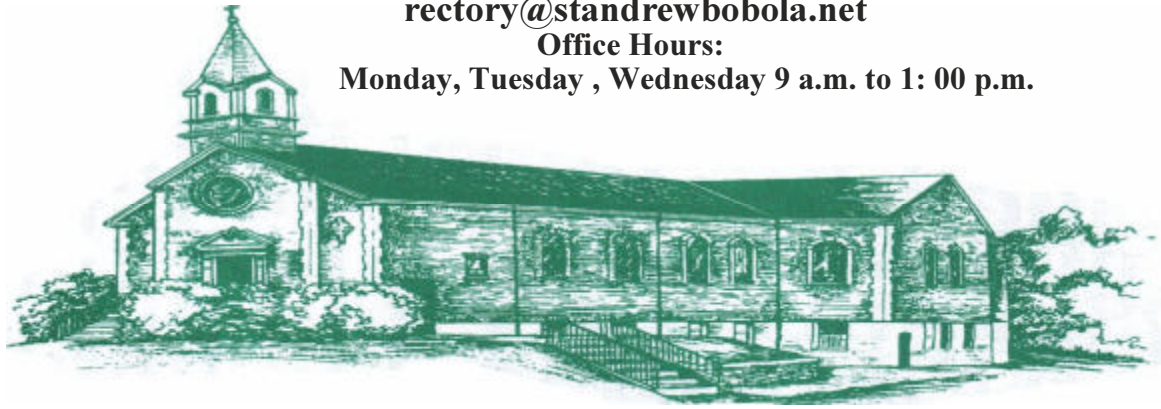

OCTOBER - THE MONTH OF THE ROSARY

By tradition, the Catholic Church dedicates each month of the year to certain devotions. The month of October is dedicated to the Holy Rosary, one of the best known of all Catholic devotions. October includes the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary on October 7. We will have a rosary devotion before morning Masses at 7:30 am (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday). In English and 6:00pm in Polish (Monday to Friday but Wednesday and Friday after Mass)

CCD REGISTRATION FOR 2021/2022

We plan to resume our CCD program starting Sunday, October 17th for grades 1 through 10.

Registration forms are now available in the church on the front altar rail where the bulletin is located. Please complete and return these forms with payment to our CCD Program Coordinator David Bugajski who can be reached at 508-461-7361 with any questions. Completed forms can also be left in the sacristy following Mass. Please put these in an envelope marked "CCD". The CCD Registration Fee is \$20 for the first child, \$10 for a second child and \$5 for a third child. CCD classes for all grades will be held on Sundays starting on October 17th. We will have Sunday Mass at 10:30am for CCD students and families. Immediately following this Mass, CCD classes will be held in the church and church hall until 12:00.

A schedule of the program year will be provided in the future. CCD classes will not be held on Christmas or Easter, or during school vacation weeks. We will review updated safety guidelines issued by the state, the CDC and the Diocese of Worcester concerning masking and social distancing. We will communicate any changes or updates before the start of the CCD program. We will keep you advised. We seek volunteers to assist with our CCD program. ALL SOUL'S DAY

On November 2nd, The Church remembers all the dead, prays for them and offers holy Masses in their intention. If someone does not have such envelope, there are additional envelopes at the door. Please write down the names of the dead and deliver them to the rectory or at the Sunday gathering after Mass.

RÓŻANIEC W PAŹDZIERNIKU



Matka Boża prosiła dzieci, „Módlcie się czyńcie ofiary za grzeszników, bo wiele dusz idzie na wieczne potępienie, gdyż nie ma nikogo, kto by się za nie modlił”.. „Przybyłam, by napomnieć wiernych do odmiany życia, aby nie zasmucali grzechami swymi Zbawiciela, który jest tak bardzo obrażany; aby odmawiali różaniec i czynili pokutę za grzechy”. Oplećmy Różańcem w październiku nasze rodziny, niech tajemnice życia Jezusa i Maryi

przenikają naszą codzienność, niech wspólna modlitwa chroni nas przed atakami szatana. Niech Maryja, Królowa Różańca Świętego, zanurzy każdą rodzinę w swoim Niepokalanym Sercu i broni przed wszelkim złem. Szczególnie w tym miesiącu pamiętajmy o modlitwie różańcowej.

W miesiącu październiku zapraszamy na Różaniec, codziennie rano przed msza o 7:30 w jez. angielskim, oraz na godz 18:00 w jez. polskim od poniedziałku do piatku. W srode i piątek rozaniec po mszy swietej.

Wspomnienie Wszystkich Wiernych Zmarłych - Kościół obchodzi 2 listopada. Kościół w tym dniu celebrować się Mszę świętą za zmarłych pokutujących za grzechy w czyśćcu. Duszom w czyśćcu możemy pomagać poprzez zamawianie za nich Mszy świętych i w pominięcie ich imion w wypominkach., czyli na specjalnych kopertach – “All Souls” wypisujemy imiona naszych zmarłych. Jeżeli ktoś nie ma takiej koperty na wypominki, przy drzwiach wyjściowych są umieszczone dodatkowe koperty. Proszę na nich wypisać imiona zmarłych i dostarczyć do plebanii lub w czasie niedzielnej kolekty. Za dusze zmarłe będą odprowadzane mszę świętą, oraz przez cały listopad będzie odmawiany Różaniec 20 minut przed poranną Mszą świętą. Aby przyjść z pomocą zmarłym pokutującym w czyśćcu, możemy uzyskać dla nich odpust zupełny. Warunki uzyskania odpustu zupełnego: Nawiedzenie kościoła w uroczystość Wszystkich Świętych, oraz w Dniu Zaduszny, Wzbudzić intencję jego otrzymania, Być w stanie łaski uświęcającej, Wyzbyć się przywiązania do jakiegokolwiek grzechu, Przyjąć w tym dniu Komunię Świętą, Odnówić “Ojciec nasz”, “Wierzę w Boga” oraz modlitwy w intencjach bliskich Ojcu Świętemu. Ponadto możemy uzyskać dla nich odpust zupełny od 1 do 8 listopada za pobożne nawiedzenie cmentarza z modlitwą za zmarłych.

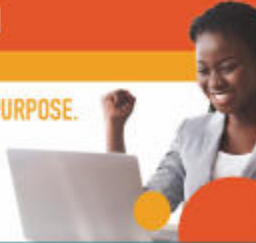
