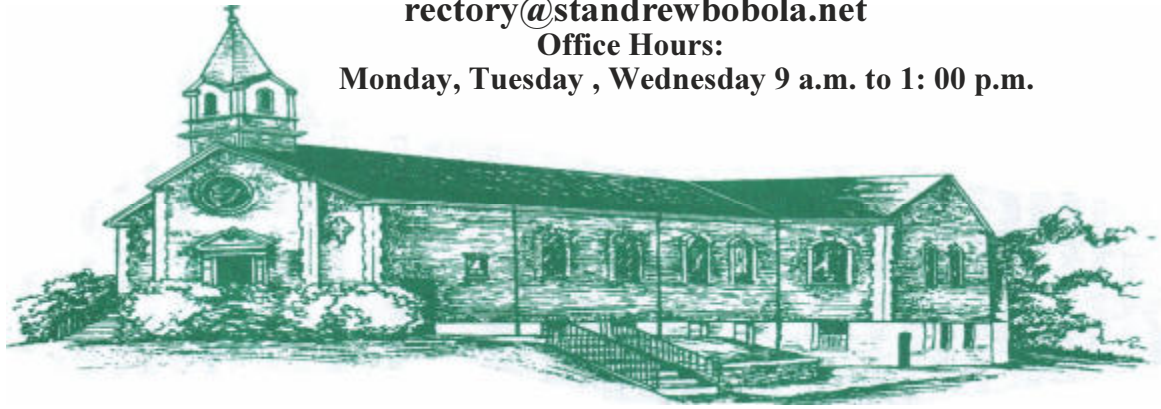

Done for the Season – The last **Drive Thru Polish Dinner** event of the season was held last weekend; in totality, this has been a great fundraiser for our Parish. There is no question about the amount of work that goes into making this event a success and our thanks goes out to the teams of parishioners who have donated their time to make the pierogi, gołąbki and bigos, and to the team that volunteers on the drive thru day to sell, pack and fill orders. It was great to see some new faces in each group as we went along – we hope this continues when we start up again in 2022. As you know, these dinners have replaced the income we lost from the inability to run a festival, so your support was greatly appreciated.

Taste of the Diocese – The Parish was invited to participate in the Taste of the Diocese, being held on Oct 28 at the new St. Paul Jr/Sr High School in Worcester. Pierogi, kielbasa and bigos were donated and volunteers from the Parish served the food during the event. We are proud to be representing the Polish culture in our Diocese!

Volunteers to clean the church on Saturday Nov. 6 at 9 a.m. Less than a couple hours are needed if several people volunteer for this task.

Pierogi will be made in 2 sessions in November, the first one on November 6 at 9 a.m. The pierogi made on these 2 days will be used to support the frozen food sale that will take place in conjunction with the Holy Rosary Sodality event on December 4, and for the ongoing frozen Polish food sales. REFLECTION

The feast of All Saints tells us - how you become a saint. This day is necessary. We need to hear what this feast says to us. It is a summons, a call, a challenge to every one. This feast says to us: dare to be more. Dare to be a saint. Some of us may hear that and laugh. Sainthood is a noble ambition, an ideal, but is this something we can realistically expect to attain? Yes, because the great truth about saints, something we so easily forget, is that they were just like us. Flesh and blood, strength and weakness. They were simple sinners just like the rest of us. That was how they began. But that wasn't the whole story. The simple but reassuring fact is that nobody is born a saint. It's something you have to become. Don't dismiss any of the saints. They are closer to us than we may realize. They have struggled with sin and temptation, they've walked the journey toward holiness, sometimes stumbling, sometimes falling, but always getting back up and moving on, resolving to do better, to be better, to aim higher. They worked to be what this gospel is calling us to be. To be poor in spirit. To be meek. To be merciful. To make peace. This is how we begin to become what Jesus called "blessed," and what the Church calls saints. All Saints Day reminds us of our great potential - the promise that lies within each of us. The promise of holiness.

ALL SOUL'S DAY

On November 2nd, The Church remembers all the dead, prays for them and offers holy Masses in their intention. We can help souls suffering in purgatory by ordering masses for them and mentioning their names in the memorials, that is, on special envelopes - "All Souls" we write the names of our dead. If someone does not have such envelope, there are additional envelopes at the door. Please write down the names of the dead and deliver them to the rectory or at the Sunday gathering after Mass.

CCD REGISTRATION FOR 2021/2022

We started our CCD program on October 17th for grades 1 through 10, but is not too late to register your children and give them opportunity to grow in faith. UROCZYSTOSC WSZYSTKICH SWIETYCH

„Świętymi bądźcie, bo ja jestem Święty, mówi Bóg" Wspominamy dziś świętych i wspominamy zmarłych naszych bliskich, z których wielu jest już w ich gronie. Wszyscy zbawieni są święci. Pomyślmy i o naszej świętości, o tym, że jesteśmy w drodze do nieba. Chodzi o to, abyśmy za kilka, kilkanaście czy kilkadziesiąt lat, kiedy odprowadzą nas na cmentarz, należeli do grona świętych. W naszym wyznaniu wiary powtarzamy: „Wierzę w świętych obcowanie” — tzn. wierzę w istnienie łączności między świętymi a mną, wierzę w to, że mogę obcować ze świętymi, a dzieje się to tylko wtedy, kiedy znam konkretnego świętego i mogę z nim zawrzeć przyjaźń. To mnie wprowadzi w wielką wspólnotę ludzi, którzy potrafili wygrać życie. Znamy zyciorysy św. Maksymiliana Kolbego, św. Brata Alberta, św. Rafała Kalinowskiego, Sw. Jana Pawła II, Św. Fustyny, Św. Andrzeja Boboli. Byli zwykłymi ludźmi jak my. Nikt z nich nie urodził się święty, ale przez lata zmagają ze swymi słabościami i grzesznością starali się żyć Ewangelią naszego Pana. W spotkaniu z świętymi widzimy, że droga Ewangelii jest drogą możliwą do przebycia także dla ciebie. Istnieje wspólnota ludzi w niebie żyjących miłością, jeżeli chcemy do tej wiecznej wspólnoty należeć, musimy miłować Boga i ludzi żyjących obok nas tak jak oni miłowali

Wspomnienie Wszystkich Wiernych Zmarłych -

Kościół obchodzi 2 listopada. Kościół w tym dniu celebrować się Mszę świętą za zmarłych pokutujących za grzechy w czyśćcu. Duszom w czyśćcu możemy pomagać poprzez zamawianie za nich Mszy świętych i wzmiankowanie ich imion w wypominkach., czyli na specjalnych kopertach – “All Souls” wypisujemy imiona naszych zmarłych. Jeżeli ktoś nie ma takiej koperty na wypominki, przy drzwiach wyjściowych są umieszczone dodatkowe koperty. Proszę na nich wypisać imiona zmarłych i dostarczyć do plebanii lub w czasie niedzielnej kolekty. Za dusze zmarłe będą odprowadzane mszę świętą, oraz przez cały listopad będzie odmawiany Różaniec 20 minut przed poranną Mszą świętą. Aby przyjść z pomocą zmarłym pokutującym w czyśćcu, możemy uzyskać dla nich odpust zupełny. Warunki uzyskania odpustu zupełnego: Nawiedzenie kościoła w uroczystość Wszystkich Świętych, oraz w Dniu Zaduszny, Wzbudzić intencję jego otrzymania, Być w stanie łaski uświęcającej, Wyzbyć się przywiązania do jakiegokolwiek grzechu, Przyjąć w tym dniu Komunię Świętą, Odnowić “Ojcze nasz”, “Wierzę w Boga” oraz modlitwy w intencjach bliskich Ojcu Świętemu. Ponadto możemy uzyskać dla nich odpust zupełny od 1 do 8 listopada za pobożne nawiedzenie cmentarza z modlitwą za zmarłych.
