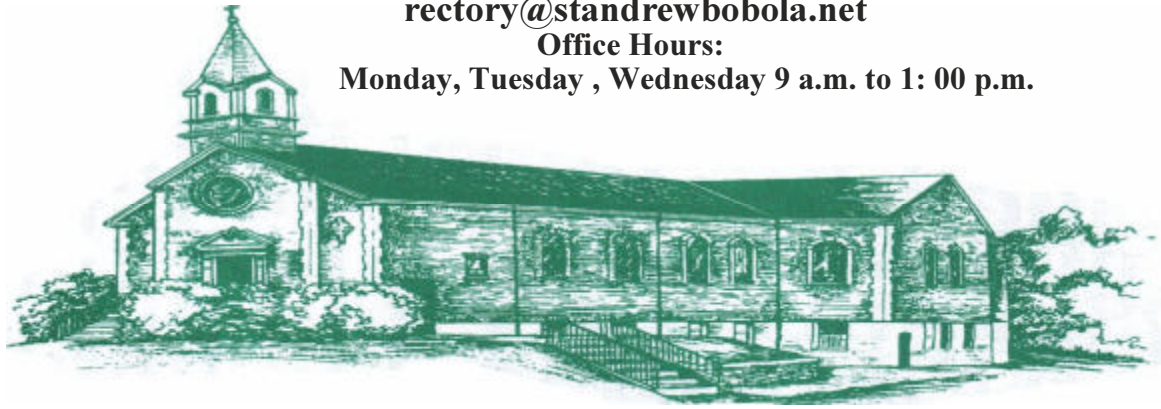

**Zmawianie Intencji Mszalnych**

W naszej parafii brakuje intencji mszalnych szczególnie w dni powszednie. Niektórzy parafianie zamawiają intencje, ale tylko w niedziele na polskiej mszy. Z tego powodu kalendarz z intencjami mszalnymi szczególnie na tygodniu jest pusty. W Jaką wartość duchową ma Msza święta? We Mszy świętej uobecnia się jedyna ofiara Chrystusa - Jezus umiera za nas, spłacając dług naszych grzechów, i przywraca nam nowe życie. Jest to więc źródło, z którego wypływają wszystkie łaski. Ofiarowanie Mszy świętej w jakiejś intencji to bez wątpienia największy dar duchowy, jakim możemy kogokolwiek obdarzyć. Intencją mszalną można więc objąć żywych - naszych bliskich, przyjaciół, kapłanów, z okazji urodzin, jubileuszy czy ważnych wydarzeń w ich życiu. Możemy się także modlić za naszych zmarłych - aby jak najszybciej mogli uczestniczyć w chwale nieba. Proszę każdą rodzinę naszej parafii, aby zatroszczyła się duchowo o swoich najbliższych i zamówiła intencje mszalne w ich potrzebach duchowych. Było by dobrze uczestniczyć w tej mszy świętej i przyjąć Komunię świętą, ale nawet jeżeli nie możemy sami uczestniczyć w zamawianej mszy, to ta Ofiara Mszy jest ważna i jej owoce otrzymują ci za których się modlimy.
