

As I announced prior to our Parish Yard Sale, all the proceeds would be put towards the principal of the Roof Loan, all \$10,300. Also, in conjunction with that we have had generous donors who have given money towards the roof loan over the last six months. So with the proceeds from the Yard Sale and these other donations we were able to give the Diocese of Manchester a check for \$20,000 to reduce the principal of the roof loan from \$227,000 to \$207,000.

The Baptism of the Lord –

This weekend we complete our Christmas season by celebrating the Feast of Jesus' baptism. The angels announced his coming to shepherds who came and saw the infinite mercy and love of God made visible in the infant lying in a manger. Last weekend in the beautiful celebration of the Epiphany the magi came from the East to adore the new born King. They represent all Gentile nations whom God shines his light of mercy upon and draws them into His kingdom of light, love and truth. Today on this feast of Jesus' baptism once again Jesus is revealed as the beloved Son of the Father in whom he is well pleased.
