From the Parish Administrator

On this Father's Day, I want to wish all Fathers, Grandfathers, and Father figures a very happy and blessed day. Thank you for all that you do for your families, communities, and the Church.

I want to thank everyone for their support as we work through the Bell Tower situation. Individuals and groups from our parish and from around our community have reached out to assist us. I am deeply grateful. I hope to be able to provide a more substantive update by the end of June. We are looking at both short-term and long-term steps. We are having discussions with a number of firms to determine our options for the repairs and the costs.

We have 23 pilgrims from our parishes and parishes across the Diocese who will be spending three days in Quebec visiting holy sites in Three Rivers, St. Anne de Beaupré, and Quebec City. We will be sure to keep all of you and your intentions in our prayers.
