### For Your Reflection

#### Feast of the Holy Family Rev. Michael Moore, OMI, December 2017

This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. It is true to say the attention leading up and during the celebration of the Nativity is Jesus. This Sunday we acknowledge the whole family! There is a sense of nostalgia and romance about the birth of Jesus. This can be heard and seen in Christmas Carols and Christmas cards. These cards show a crisp winter night, stars in the sky and snow on the manger, but we need to look beyond, particularly on this great and important feast. Mary was called personally by name and asked to take on what would seem an impossible task. However, she was not expected to do what she was asked by herself or to rely on her on own efforts or strength. On hearing she was to be the mother of Jesus, 'she was deeply disturbed and wondered what the greeting could mean.' Told not to be afraid, she was filled with the Holy Spirit. She was strengthened and encouraged to do what was asked of her. Joseph too was called to take on a role. Like Mary, he too heard the message, 'do not to be afraid.' God who called them would not ignore or abandoned them as they became the parents of Jesus. Jesus too in his own life and ministry was guided and led by God. He said, 'The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, I have been called to bring the good news to the poor.' Even Jesus does not rely on his own efforts!

On this feast of the Holy Family, it good to pray in grateful thanksgiving for our parents and family. No family is perfect. Our family members, including ourselves, have made mistakes and done wrong. We have all done and said things we later regret. Regardless, we owe our family everything and for this we thanks God. St. Eugene deMazenod, founder of the Oblates of Mary Immaculate, came from what could be called a 'broken family.' His parent's divorced in 1795 when Eugene was 17 years old. This happened when divorce was rare. Eugene had a far from ideal family life. He is the patron saint of broken families. Prayers to St. Eugene can help and support people experiencing problems in family life. On this feast day, let us pray for all experiencing the pain and difficulty of problems in married and family life. May the Holy Family of Nazareth bless, guide and protect all our families, now and always.

## Respect Life: Popular Company Promotes Satanic Child Knifing another Child

Online store, Etsy, is selling *children's T-shirts* with *satanic* and murderous messages. One children's t-shirt says, "*Let's sacrifice Toby*." On the shirt is a young boy laying on his back with legs being held by another young boy. A cute, pig-tailed little girl kneeling to the side holds a large long-bladed knife raised above her head ready to stab down the boy. Nearby is a hissing black cat and children's wooden toy blocks painted with the demon numbers 6-6-6. It's hard to believe how deep society has sunk. Now, we have the shameless promotion of child sacrifice! The image leaves no doubt what they are trying to normalize. Etsy is allowing vendors to sell versions of this shirt. This is dangerous! The "*Let's Sacrifice Toby*" shirt trivializes and promotes child sacrifice and satanic murder child-to-child; many children might think it's a fun thing to do. Another satanic children's shirt says, "*Let's Summon Demons*." Satanic items pose a serious threat to society and are hateful attacks on Christians and children as they inspire violence and hate and stifle the grace of God in souls. These are offenses against God and a direct threat to America and the world. They repel the blessings of God.

In the past, Etsy was found selling "consecrated hosts" for satanic practices. Though this item was removed, others items for satanic practices persist. There are images of burning churches on t-shirts and other products. One product, a "Burning Church Card" has the description, "The perfect card to celebrate your most recent church burning." There are also inverted crucifixes, Satanic "rosaries" and other "religious" items for immoral use. All this in contradiction of Etsy's policy: "Etsy does not allow items or listings that promote, support or glorify hatred toward people or otherwise demean people based upon religion."
