# Biden Administration Rolls Back Key Federal Religious Liberty Protections Dec. 3, 2021; firstliberty.org

The Biden administration has shown disdain for the Constitution and the sincerely held religious beliefs of millions of Americans. A high-profile attack on religious liberty came when the President mobilized the Department of Labor's (DOL) Occupational Safety & Health Administration to impose a vaccine and testing requirement on businesses with 100 or more employees a policy that threatens the freedom of millions of people of faith. The policy was met with a wave of legal challenges, including First Liberty filing lawsuits on behalf of 3 prominent national religious organizations: Daystar Television Network, American Family Association, and Answers in Genesis, asking federal appellate courts to review the rule. Recently, the DOL took yet another alarming step announcing plans to rescind a rule that broadened religious exemptions and prevent discrimination against religious organizations who contract with the government. Additionally, the U.S. Dept of Health and Human Services (HHS) revoked authority delegated to the Office of Civil Rights, an agency created to prevent religious liberty violations.

While these actions are troubling and harmful, they do not come as a surprise. Days before Biden's inauguration, First Liberty's legal experts took inventory and warned of 10 religious freedom policy advances that could be reversed. As we witness the slashing of regulations and religious protections, our warnings were correct, such as making it harder for religious groups to contract with the federal government. The DOL rule the Biden administration is seeking to cut, entitled "Implementing Legal Requirements Regarding the Equal Opportunity Clause's Religious Exemption," has been in place since January. Its adoption ensures religious organizations seeking to contract with the federal government would be free to do so on equal terms as others. It clarified that faith-based organizations do not have to abandon their religious character and mission to be eligible for federal contracts. Though it appears like regulatory jargon, it served to protect faith-based ministries, charities and nonprofits across the country. Not only did it prevent discrimination against religious organizations, but was beneficial by providing assurance that religious organizations would not face discrimination due to their religious exercise. However, once Biden rolls back the rule, religious contractors and subcontractors could be deterred from partnering with the government to provide important public services.

HHS Secretary Xavier Becerra, no friend of religious freedom, recently repealed initiatives that protect the rights of conscience and religious freedom. This directive included better enforcement of the Religious Freedom Restoration Act and handling of free-exercise and religious-discrimination claims. But with Becerra's announcement, HHS will no longer operate under these guidelines. This reversal could be dangerous for religious organizations and charities, as religious freedom complaints may not receive thorough investigation. Worse, HHS regulations could be used to trample people's rights. This isn't the only troubling policy. In May, Becerra's HHS expanded the definition of "sex" to include orientation and gender identity. Under this policy, faith-based hospitals or religious providers could be forced to participate in medical procedures that violate their conscience, like sex-change surgeries or cross-sex hormone treatments for minors. This could lead to faith-based healthcare facilities and providers being excluded from the marketplace or going out of business if they provide care consistent with their religious beliefs. If Biden purports to "Build Back Better," rolling back regulations that protect religious freedom will not help our nation flourish. On the contrary, getting rid of these protections will only be harmful to millions of religious Americans.

# Respect Life: "Most Pro-Family State" Awards: #1. Most Pro-Family State: Montana

What state has the most pro-family new laws? In 2021, it's Montana. Lawmakers passed a #SaveGirlsSports law, tax credit education scholarships, and several pro-life protections including preventing abortions when the baby can feel pain. They require parental permission for sex education and succeeded in religious freedom protections (including the Religious Freedom Restoration Act). "Most Pro-Family State" was a well-deserved title!
