

Religious Formation News

Our program for 2021 will begin in December with a **series of emails** introducing the “easy to do” Home Programs for each grade level. These programs are being developed and will have easy to follow directions for parents and lessons for the children.

This will be a staggered roll out:

Grade 1: lessons went out via email this week.

Grade 2: Packets are ready for pick –up. (see below)

Grade 3: received their lessons via email the first week of December

Other grades will follow as development continues

"Give them some food yourselves."

(Matthew 14:16)

Right now, in Rhode Island, one in four households is experiencing a shortage of food. This was reported by Rhode Island Community Food Bank on November 23. Throughout the United States, more than 30 million Americans are facing food insecurity.

Every year, our parish dedicates a portion of its income to charities and agencies that serve the needs of people in the spirit of Christ, the Gospel message, and the mission of the Catholic Church. This year, sharing program is supporting food pantries in Rhode Island.

In September, we donated \$3,000 to the McAuley Ministries COVID-19 Relief Fund. In October, we gave \$3,000 to the Jonnycake Center in Wakefield. Last month, we gave \$3,000 to the Rhode Island Community Food Bank, which distributes more than 300,000 pounds of food weekly to its statewide network of 168 agencies.

December's contribution will be \$3,000 to the Assumption Church Food Pantry in Providence.

The parish sharing program is funded by your regular weekly offering. Our target this year is to send \$30,000 to local agencies that are working to help relieve food insecurity in Rhode Island. Extra donations are welcome and will be added to the total – simply mark your donation (envelope or check) with the word "outreach" before sending it to the office or placing it in the collection drop box at church.

It is now often said of the pandemic that "we are all in the same *storm*, but we are not all in the same *boat*." This is the message to keep in mind as we pray and give alms in the Lord's name, helping to keep everyone afloat.

Because of the great generosity of our Christ the King parishioners in the past, thousands of children have had better Christmases.




This year, due to the virus, our Giving Tree is asking for a different form of generosity. Instead of presents this year, we are asking that you give only actual gift cards or checks. We are hoping to distribute more than 650 gift cards to the Providence parishes of Assumption, St. Michael's, St. Patrick's, and St. Thomas's. In addition, we also give to children who are in the Domestic Violence Safe House, refugees in Providence, and specific families in need. You can buy gift cards for a variety of businesses in Stop and Shop. Requested gift cards are from Walmart, Amazon, Stop and Shop, and Best Buy. If you drop your donated card or your check (with the memo notation of the Giving Tree) in the church collection box, you will be helping a child have a better Christmas this year, in this time of anxiety and even greater need. We have received a little more than half the cards requested. GIFT CARD SCAM WARNING!

As we begin to collect gift cards this year for our Giving Tree program, please remember NEVER to respond to an e-mail asking you to purchase gift cards and send their numbers and codes to the sender. Parishioners often receive fraudulent e-mails and text messages from scammers claiming to be Fr. Jared, asking them to call him or email him. The parishioner is then asked for financial assistance in the form of gift cards. DO NOT REPLY to any text or email message claiming to be from Fr. Jared, asking you to return the message or send codes from an iTunes gift card (or any codes from any gift card).

FRIENDLY VISITOR MESSAGE

When you are being careful and staying away from most people and the people you do see regularly may be busy with holiday busyness, it is easy to feel more lonely and cut off from the rest of the community. This is a perfect time to request a Friendly Visitor. There are folks here at Christ the King who would love to talk with you when you are feeling down. Financial Report for the Fiscal Year June 30, 2019 - June 30, 2020

PARISH OFFERTORY

The regular weekly collection for the year totaled \$864,808, an 8.9% decrease from the previous fiscal year. When the church closed in March, we weren't sure what to expect, but thanks to the those who used online giving and mailed in their parish support, we prevented what could have been a much greater loss. If you have been unable to support the parish this year, it's perfectly understandable. Please know that we have been praying for you at Masses throughout the year. By the grace of God, the mission and ministry of the parish continue, and everyone is a part of it: those who remain able to support the parish financially, those who continue to support the community with their prayers and stewardship. As we celebrate Christmas together, please think about a Christmas gift to the parish, especially if you haven't given to the church this year as you normally would. Our online giving service is very convenient and efficient, and it has saved us in many ways this year – see our parish website to give. You can also send your gift to the parish office.

DIOCESAN COLLECTIONS

Grateful for God's Providence – This four-year diocesan capital campaign was established to support seminarians, retired priests, catholic schools, catholic charities, social services, the Cathedral of Saints Peter and Paul, and parishes. This summer, it was announced that the Diocese surpassed its goal of \$50 million. In such a tumultuous time in the Catholic Church, this is nothing short of a miracle. Parishioners here pledged more than \$550,000 to the campaign – 40% of which is coming back to Christ the King. This fiscal year, \$104,784 has been collected by the Diocese, and the parish received \$41,914. The parish share was earmarked for capital projects here at the church, as well as several charities including the Holy Family Home for Women and Children in Providence, Catholic Relief Services, and the Catholic Medical Mission Board.

Catholic Charity Appeal – This year, we joined with our Catholic family in Rhode Island and contributed \$103,040 to the annual Catholic Charity Appeal. These donations support the work of our diocesan church, including social service ministries that provide direct support to hundreds of thousands of Rhode Islanders: from the hungry and the homeless to immigrants and refugees and those in need of emergency rent and medical assistance.

Special Collections – Our parish contributed an additional \$27,994 to charities that are supported through special collections, including Catholic Relief Services; Operation Rice Bowl; the Church in Latin America; and the charitable works of Pope Francis. Some of the funds went to support retired priests and religious, seminarians studying for the priesthood, and the annual mission appeal, when we contributed \$9,763 to support the ministry of the Marist Missionary Sisters.

OUTREACH/SOCIAL MINISTRY

Our annual giving to charities was \$68,914. This year's agencies included: Amos House, Welcome House, Clothes to Kids, Habitat for Humanity, RICAN, St. Thomas Food Pantry, WARM Shelter, Operation Stand Down, Pawtucket Soup Kitchen, Habitat For Humanity, and Assumption Church in Providence, which received \$13,500.

ANNUAL TOTAL

All told, parishioners gave more than \$1.1 million “to and through” Christ the King Church! Keep up your tremendous generosity as together we continue the mission and ministry entrusted to us by the Lord. And be sure to read the parish bulletin and the Mustard Seed Newsletter to learn about all we do together to bring the joy and hope of the Gospel to so many of our brothers and sisters in need throughout Rhode Island and around the world!
