From The Pastor

This is an important weekend at IC and SA – it is First Eucharist weekend and one of the most important celebrations of the Church year. St. Andrew's will celebrate First Eucharist today at the 10:30am mass and Immaculate Conception will celebrate First Eucharist at a special mass today at 1pm. We congratulate and salute all our children who will receive Jesus in the Holy Eucharist today for the first time. We hope their parents will bring them here often for this wonderful meeting with Jesus in the Eucharist.

Next weekend is Mother's Day and we will honor all of our mothers – living or deceased. When you come to mass next weekend, you will find a Mother's Day prayer card in the pew. Please write the name of your mother, living or deceased, on the card. The cards will be collected after the 2nd collection and brought to the altar and we will pray for all of our mothers during the Eucharistic Prayer.

Mark your calendars: The Sisters of the Cross will host an OPEN HOUSE on Sunday, May 15 at their new home in the former rectory at SA. It will begin after the 10:30am mass and continue until about 2pm. This will take the place of the regular coffee hour at SA. Please plan on visiting the Sisters and taking a tour of their new home! PS: you can check under their beds to see if there is any dust collecting there!

Sometimes we forget that the Easter Season lasts for 50 days, so here is another one: Some years ago, I was visiting a 2nd grade class in one of our Diocesan Catholic Schools. The topic they were discussing was Easter. I asked the children some pertinent questions: "Who is God's son?; Tell me about Jesus; How did he die?" The children thought and thought and finally one child responded, " I think it was poison ivy!" One of the joys of working with children is that we never know what they will say.

ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP:

T'is the season for planting. Seeds bring beauty to the earth and food to our tables. Jesus often made reference to seeds to teach us lessons about life (i.e., Mt 13:31-32; Mark 4:26-29). The Benedictine Book of Blessings has a Blessing for Seeds (#986-1006). Consider taking a few minutes to pray a blessing over any seeds or seedlings that you plant this spring and pray that the seeds farmers are planting will produce much food.
