Happy Mother's Day to all of our mothers who have given us so much wisdom over the years. These are the top 10 things Mothers always say. See if any of these sound familiar to you:

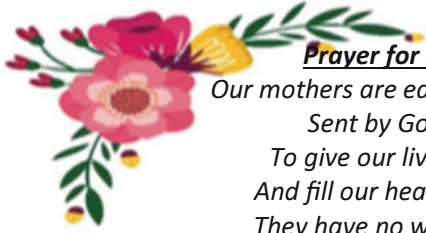
Because I said so!

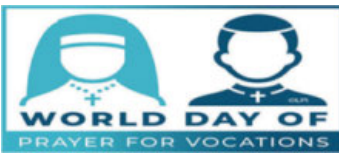

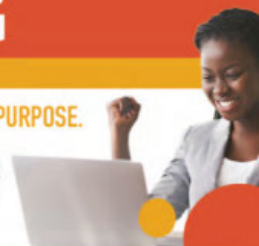
