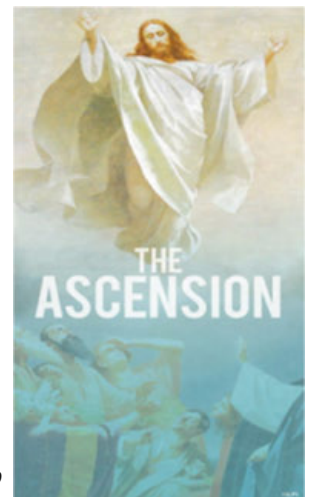
**From The Pastor**

Over 3 years ago I began planning a pilgrimage to Italy and the Passion Play at Oberammergau, Germany. Well, I don't have to tell you what happened. COVID wiped out the whole trip and the Passion Play was moved to 2022. So, FINALLY tomorrow at 6am, thirty-five of my closest and dearest friends and I will board a charter bus from the IC parking lot to begin our pilgrimage. We will travel to JFK airport to board a 4pm flight to Rome after a brief stopover in Frankfurt. We will arrive in Rome on Tuesday morning to begin our adventure. On Wednesday morning we will attend an audience with Pope Francis. Of course, there will be few others in attendance – a few thousand! I am quite certain that the Holy Father will want to know how everyone is doing in Brownville/Sackets. In the afternoon, we will tour the Major Basilicas of Rome – St. Mary Major, St. John Lateran and St. Paul's Outside of the Wall. Thursday will find us completing more sightseeing in Rome – Vatican City with the Vatican Museum, the Sistine Chapel, St. Peter's Basilica, etc. On Friday, we will travel through the province of Umbria to Assisi, the famous city of St. Francis. In Assisi we will tour the Basilica of St. Francis, the Church of St. Clare and Santa Maria degli Angeli. In the latter part of the day, we will head to Florence, the jewel of Renaissance Art and former stronghold of the Medici family. We will spend Saturday in Florence with stops at the Duomo and the Baptistery, an opportunity to see the original statue of David. The famous Ponte Vecchio and Arno Valley will be highlights. I will be celebrating Mass on most days and you will be in my thoughts and prayers. Father Michael Gaffney will be "covering" for me for the 10 days that I am away. Perhaps some of you remember him. He was Pastor here for 9 years before I came on the scene.

Thursday is the Feast Day of the Ascension. It is a Holyday of Obligation and mass schedule is printed herein.

The date has been changed so we don't interfere with the annual Memorial Day weekend K of C hotdog sale and rummage sale to be held in and around the Parish Center. 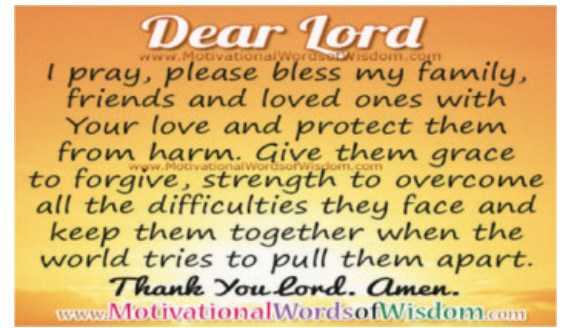

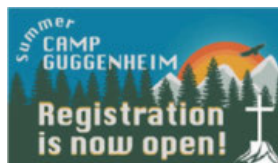
