From The Pastor

We are continuing on our Pilgrimage to Italy and the Passion Play at Oberammergau; we are into the 2nd week. The weather in Italy has been very mild and warm; the Italian food delicious and the people so warm and accommodating. We saw Pope Francis on Wednesday and he sends his regards to all the parishioners in IC and SA. Today (Sunday) finds us in romantic Venice. It is built on 118 small islands lying 4 kilometers from the mainland. The highways are made of water and the islands are linked by numerous, beautiful bridges. We took a walking tour of the city beginning at St. Marks's Square. On Monday we will drive through Northern Italy into the Tyrolean Alps and continue to Innsbruck, capital of the Austrian Province. I should have brought my skis. Tuesday is the highlight of the trip and the very reason for this Pilgrimage. We will arrive in Oberammergau, site of the world-famous Passion Play. In keeping with their 389-year old promise, the villagers of this small German town present their Passion Play every 10 years depicting the last week of the life of Christ. The play's presentation can be traced to 1633 when the Black Plague swept Europe. The people of Oberammergau took a solemn oath: if God spared them, they would present a day-long play depicting the last week in the life of Christ. To this day they have kept their promise and the citizens of the town present their Passion Play with the same love and devotion they have shown for over 300 years. The play takes place on an open-air stage with a covered auditorium seating 4,700, against a beautiful backdrop of towering Alpine Mountains. On Wednesday, we drive to Munich, the capital of Bavaria. After a tour of the city we will proceed to Augsburg for our final stay. On Thursday, we transfer to the Munich airport for our flight back to the USA. We should arrive back on Thursday night.

Next Sunday is the all-important Feast of Pentecost. Please wear something red to mass – that is the color of the Holy Spirit!

Registration is now open for Camp Guggenheim for the July/August 2022 camp season. If there are any young people between the age of 12-18 in IC or SA who would be interested in attending Camp for one of the weekly sessions and you need some financial assistance, please see me. God's Game of Telephone

You've probably played the game of "pass it on" before, maybe years ago on the playground. It's a simple concept: one person whispers something in another person's ear, and it gets repeated person by person throughout the group, until finally the last one to hear the message has to say it out loud. Whatever ends up being said at the end of the game is usually a far cry from the original statement, and everyone has a good laugh.

As individuals, we don't receive news in the same way. Our personalities, our histories, our weaknesses, and our strengths determine how we interact with information we encounter in the world, both good and bad. One person will interpret a compliment positively; someone else will take offense. One person reacts to news of a job promotion with joy, another is disappointed that now they will have less time with their family. The same news can mean completely different things to different people. But what God gives us is the truth in love, and the truth in love is the same in every place and in every time, for every person of every race. When Christ prayed to the Father that "the love with which you loved me may be in them," he was asking that the magnificent gift that had been imparted to him would also be imparted to us.

Our job is to play a game of pass it on with this gift of love. How do we keep it from becoming warped? Through remaining committed to the word of God, to the sacraments, and to one another.
