

From the Desk of Seminarian Douglas Schirmer:

I was born in central Wisconsin to Robert and Amy, and have two younger brothers. Our family moved to St. Lawrence county in 2007. My father is an Anglican clergyman, who currently works with the Hospice of the St. Lawrence Valley, and mom is one of the secretaries at the Cathedral in Ogdensburg.

My family moved around a great deal when I was young: mom's side of the family have been missionaries in Africa for three generations, and when I was 12-13 we moved to Zambia for a year. After we returned, mom came into the Catholic church when I was 15. After 7 years of reading and looking into the Church, my brothers and I each came "across the Tiber"; interestingly, none of us had talked to the others about it, and we came in several months apart. (I'll tell you all more about that sometime). I moved to Nebraska to join one of my brothers in 2013, right after I entered the Church. Over a year later, during a discernment retreat with Father's Bryan Stitt and Joseph Giroux, I began actively discerning the call to seminary. Once that course had been settled on, I moved back to the Diocese of Ogdensburg and applied to be a seminarian.

Before seminary, I had some experience doing small-scale farming, and spent 6 years working as a butcher. Once seminary began, I studied philosophy and liberal arts at the Pontifical College Josephinum for four years, and received my bachelor's degree in the mail during Coronatide, 2020. In the fall of 2020, I and three of my classmates began our studies in theology at Mount St. Mary's Seminary in Emmitsburg, Maryland. I just finished my second year of theology, and am pursuing an MA with a focus in Moral Theology.

I'm so happy to be here this summer, and look forward to meeting and working with you all! May the Risen Lord keep you and your loved ones close to His Sacred Heart.
