## June 19 From The Pastor

HAPPY FATHER'S DAY! When you come into Mass today you will find a Father's Day prayer card in the pew. Please fill it out with the name of your father, living or deceased. The cards will be collected after the offertory collection and then brought to the altar and we will pray for all of our fathers during the Eucharistic Prayer. A special Father's Day gift will be given out at the end of mass. Sorry, we will not be able to give out Rolex watches this year, what with the difficult economic times!

The practice of having Massed offered for those who have died as well as the living dates back to the early Church. While many of our Mass Intentions are for the faithful departed, we also have Masses celebrated for the living. As Catholics, we believe the Mass to be the highest act of worship and the greatest form of prayer. We have a strong history of having Masses offered at both IC and SA. But the scheduling of Mass Intentions is more challenging than in the past. Sometimes we forget that there can be only one Intention per Mass. Marilynn Hibbard in the Parish Office is very fair and conscientious in trying to meet all the requests she receives. Keep in mind that the Mass Intention is required to be offered within a year of it being received. Therefore, sometimes it is necessary to send out Mass Intentions to the Propagation of the Faith Office in Ogdensburg or to some local retired priests. Starting now, when parishioners have multiple Mass Intentions to be satisfied, only 2 will be scheduled on a weekend in any particular year and the remainder ones will be celebrated on a weekday. What is important is that we focus on the Mass being celebrated and the Intention being fulfilled, and the person receiving the spiritual benefits of having a Mass offered for them.
