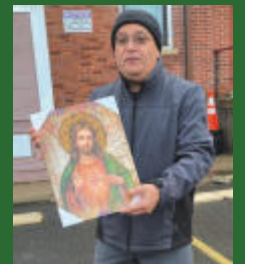

The contributions from both programs were extraordinary! The school alone contributed close to 200 gifts and in total we more than doubled the number of gifts we were able to give to the McGivney Christmas shopping program.

We know everyone's efforts will have a positive impact and will definitely help brighten the Christmas of so many in need and we offer an account of the generosity of our parishioners and families:

**Blessed Sacrament Church** - more than 100 scarf/gloves. **St. Charles Borromeo** - 181 gifts delivered for 50 families. **Convent of Mary Immaculate** - 102 gifts for their pre-school and First Communion students. **St. Mary's Church** - 146 gifts delivered for their religious education students. **The McGivney Center** - 468 gifts for their Christmas shopping program

In total, this is more than 1,000 gifts. In addition to fulfilling all of the gift requests, the parish also gave these 5 organizations between Thanksgiving and Christmas \$9,800 to help their families in need with food, clothes and Christmas gifts. ## EPIPHANY PROCLAMATION AND BLESSING OF CHALK

The Epiphany  
Blessing of Chalk and  
homes is an ancient

tradition which places a reminder of God's presence at the entrance of a home, and places an entire family under His protection. After the blessing at Mass, we invite you to take a piece of the blessed chalk home with you for your family's use in invoking God's blessing on your home.



## The Blessing of Chalk at Epiphany

*The Epiphany Blessing of a Home takes place as follows:*

At a convenient time on the Feast of the Epiphany, all the members of the family should gather near the front door, and all begin with the Sign of the Cross: **In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.**

Then, the head of the household says: **From the east came the Magi to Bethlehem to adore the Lord; and opening their treasures they offered Him precious gifts: gold for the great King, incense for the true God, and myrrh in symbol of His burial.**

Then all pray the **Our Father**.

Then the head of the household says: **Let us pray: O God, who on this day revealed your Only Begotten Son to the nations by the guidance of a star, grant in your mercy that we, who know you already by faith, may be brought to behold the beauty of your sublime glory. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.**

Then the head of the household (if necessary climbs a stool or small ladder and) using the blessed chalk, first writes the initials of the three Wise Men, connected with Crosses, over the inside of the front door, on the lintel, if possible. Then is written the current year, dividing the first two and last two numbers of the year so that they fall on both sides of the initials.

It should look like this:

**20 + C + M + B + 22**

...with the "20" being the millennium and century, the "C" standing for Caspar, the "M" standing for Melchior, the "B" standing for Balthasar, and the "22" at the end standing for the decade and year. (Next year, it would be 20 + C + M + B + 23, and so forth).

When the initials have been inscribed above the door, all conclude with the prayer: **Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.**

The blessing concludes with all making the Sign of the Cross: **In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.**

After all the people had been baptized and Jesus also had been baptized and was praying, heaven was opened and the Holy Spirit descended upon him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from heaven, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased." *Luke 3:15-16, 21-22*

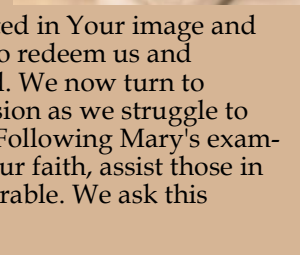

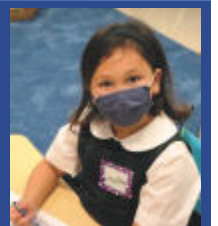

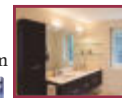
