


Advent has a twofold character,

Today begins a new liturgical year. It is a time for new beginnings, and a time to live more intentionally as disciples of Jesus.

Together we have thought and prayed about the question:

*What return can I make to the Lord for
all the good He has done for me?* (PSALM 116:12)

Next Sunday's Gospel:

THE SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT

Next weekend's Sunday Gospel reading is provided here, so that we can think and pray about it, and be ready to receive it into our minds and hearts when it is proclaimed at Mass.

John the Baptist appeared, preaching in the desert of Judea and saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!" It was of him that the prophet Isaiah had spoken when he said: *A voice of one crying out in the desert, Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths.* John wore clothing made of camel's hair and had a leather belt around his waist. His food was locusts and wild honey. At that time Jerusalem, all Judea, and the whole region around the Jordan were going out to him and were being baptized by him in the Jordan River as they acknowledged their sins.

When he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees coming to his baptism, he said to them, "You brood of vipers! Who warned you to flee from the coming wrath? Produce good fruit as evidence of your repentance. And do not presume to say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham as our father.' For I tell you, God can raise up children to Abraham from these stones. Even now the ax lies at the root of the trees. Therefore every tree that does not bear good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire. I am baptizing you with water, for repentance, but the one who is coming after me is mightier than I. I am not worthy to carry his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. His winnowing fan is in his hand. He will clear his threshing floor and gather his wheat into his barn, but the chaff he will burn with unquenchable fire."

Matthew 3:1-12

From the Choir Loft:

Before Mass begins each Sunday with the processional hymn, the organ can be heard playing a piece of repertoire as the "prelude" to Mass. This music is usually picked by the organist to foster meditation, turning hearts and minds towards the themes of the day in order to prepare for Mass. This Sunday is the first Sunday of Advent, and the prelude for all Masses with music is *Wachet auf, ruft uns die Stimme*, BWV 645 (*Awake, calls the voice to us*) by Johann Sebastian Bach. It is what is known as a chorale prelude – that is, a liturgical composition for organ based on an existing chorale (hymn) tune. In this case, Bach set the hymn tune of the same name by Philipp Nicolai.

There are many existing theories about the reason for the invention of the chorale prelude, but one obvious reason seems to have been the introduction of melodies to the congregation. This way, when it came time for all to sing the hymn together, they would already be familiar with the tune. This is precisely the arrangement we have this Sunday: *Wachet auf* is played as the prelude followed by Philipp Nicolai's hymn (in English – *Wake, Awake for Night is Flying*) as the processional.

This hymn perfectly summarizes the overwhelming Advent theme: stay awake and be ready, for you do not know when the Lord will come.




