Mass with Anointing of the Sick at 12:00pm

Feb 11 is the liturgical memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes, and World Day of Prayer for the Sick.

On that day, we will celebrate a special Mass for anyone who is seriously ill, together with their family and/or caregivers. The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will be administered at Mass to those who are ill, and there will be a blessing of caregivers as well. Who Should Attend?

- Those soon to have surgery which will include the use of general anesthesia.
- Elderly people who have become notably weakened, even though no serious illness is present.
- Seriously ill children who have sufficient use of reason to be strengthened by the sacrament.

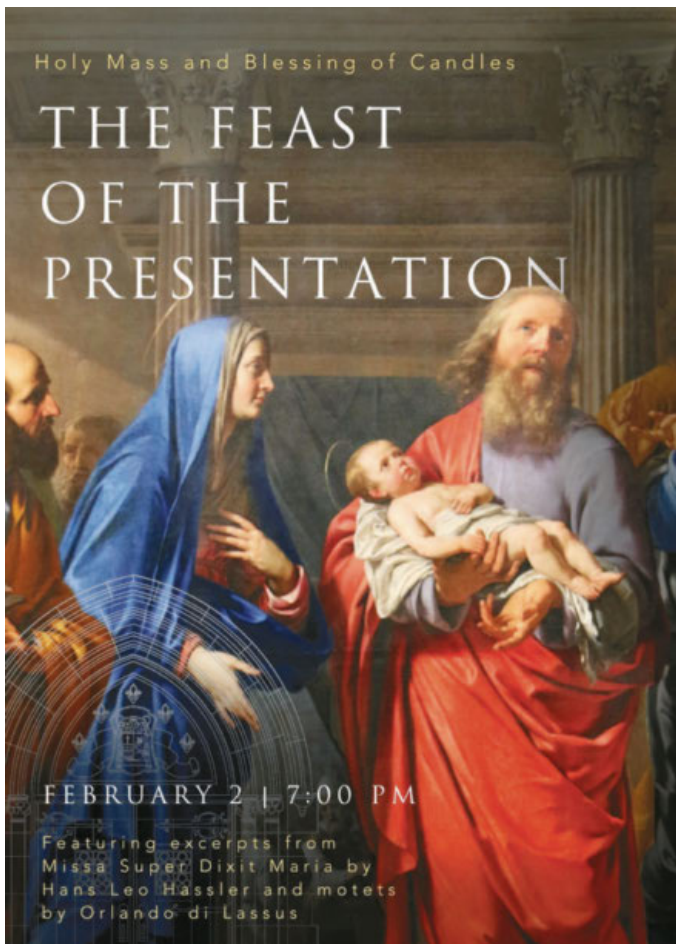

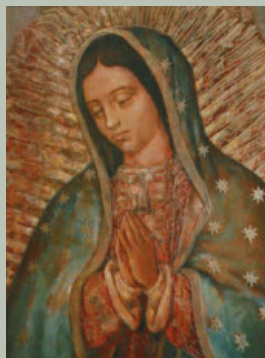
