❧ A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR ❧

Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my trust in You

Dear Friends,

The upcoming month of June is the month of the **Sacred Heart of Jesus**. The Memorial Chapel in our church is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The chapel's beautiful statue of the Sacred Heart was given to our church when it opened in 1958. Last year, an inscription along the front of the altar was added, which reads: *Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my trust in You*.

The intention of carving these words into the altar of the Sacred Heart is so that we can all learn this brief invocation, and make it part of our regular prayer: Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my trust in You. With these few, simple words, at any time of the day or night, you and I can raise our hearts and minds to Christ's Sacred Heart, with the certainty that He hears us, not just when we're here in church, but wherever we happen to be. It takes only a few seconds, and it can literally be prayed anywhere and in any circumstance, without anyone but the Lord knowing about it.

- When you've just gotten some good news, or when you've just gotten some bad news, you can pray: **Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my trust in You.**
- When you're standing in line at the grocery store or the bank, or stuck in traffic, or cutting the lawn, or when you wake up in the middle of the night: **Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my trust in You.**
- Before an important meeting, before an important conversation, before a test, before going to confession: **Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my trust in You.**
- When you're being tempted or when you're discouraged, or when it's difficult to see the way forward, still: **Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my trust in You.**

Think about it: this invocation involves an intentional act, as well as a certain vulnerability. Lord Jesus, I choose to place all my trust in your Sacred Heart – and in doing that we choose not to place our trust in our own cleverness and wisdom, but in Christ's goodness and love.

Sacred Heart of Jesus, we place all our trust in You, rather than in illusions such as "fate", or "karma" or horoscopes, or anything of that sort.

Let us bear this well in mind during the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, and let us repeat this invocation each day in our own prayer:

Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my trust in You!

FROM THE CHOIR LOFT:

NEXT SUNDAY'S GOSPEL: THE SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

Next weekend's Sunday Gospel reading is provided here, so that we can think and pray about it, and be ready to receive it into our minds and hearts when it is proclaimed at Mass.

God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him. Whoever believes in him will not be condemned, but whoever does not believe has already been condemned, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God. *John 3:16-18*



To Parents of our Children: RELAX!

God put the wiggle in children. Don't feel you have to suppress it in God's house. **Everyone is welcome here at St. Catherine's!** You may find it helpful to sit in the pews near the front, where it is easier to see and hear. Don't hesitate to quietly explain the parts of the Mass. Sing the hymns and songs, pray and voice the responses together with your children. **They**

learn liturgical behavior by copying YOU! If you need to leave Mass with your child, please feel free to do so, but please do come back! As Jesus said, *"Let the children come to Me."* Remember that the way we welcome children in Church directly affects the way they respond to the Church, to God, to Christ, and to one another. **Let them know that they are at home here!** To all the members of our Parish: a smile of encouragement is always welcome to parents with small, active children. The presence of children is a GIFT to the Church! They give us a future full of hope.

"Veni Creator Spiritus" is arguably one of the most popular chants heard in Catholic churches today. It is a Latin hymn from the ninth century and attributed to Rabanus Maurus, a German monk and archbishop. It is part of the liturgical celebrations of Pentecost, but it is also appropriately sung on any occasion during which the Holy Spirit is invoked: including papal conclaves, the installation of bishops, ordinations of priests, religious professions, Confirmation liturgies, and the dedication of churches. It is also a tradition to sing this hymn on New Years Day in order to gain a plenary indulgence. The chant has been adapted by numerous composers including Renaissance greats Thomas Luis de Victoria and Giovanni Pierluigi da Palestrina. Many organ works featuring the chant melody have also been written, the most famous of which is Maurice Duruflé's "Choral Varié sur le thème du Veni Creator". Martin Luther used this melody to write a paraphrase hymn in German, "Komm, Gott Schöpfer, Heiliger Geist". First published in 1524, this chorale melody was used on a few occasions by the great Lutheran composer, Johann Sebastian Bach. The postlude today is one of those works, "Komm, Gott Schöpfer, Heiliger Geist", BWV 631. It features the melody in the soprano line, and is written in a joyful, jaunty, triple meter.

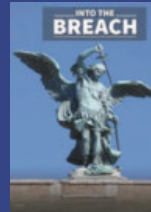

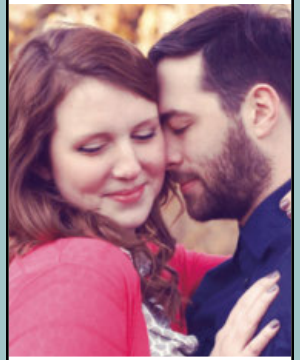

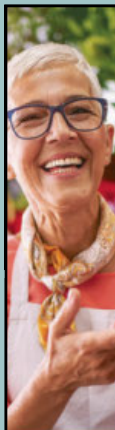
