



Dear Friends,

About five years ago, I shared with you, in this column, the story of Lucas Warren, a then-18-month-old from Dalton, Georgia, who was selected as "Gerber Spokesbaby" from among more than 140,000 photos submitted by parents. Lucas was the first child with Down Syndrome to receive this honor. Lucas' mother, Cortney Warren, told the Today Show that "he's very outgoing and never meets a stranger." And, "He loves to play, loves to laugh, and loves to make other people laugh." For other parents of children with Down Syndrome, it was a time to celebrate, and rightly so.

It is especially noteworthy that the miracle which paved the way for the beatification of Blessed Michael McGivney involved a child with Down Syndrome and his healing, in the



womb, of a severe case of fetal hydrops, a life-threatening condition involving an abnormal buildup of fluids in the tissue around the lungs, heart or abdomen, or under the skin. The doctors told Dan and Michelle Schachle, the parents of this unborn child, that they had never seen any child with such a severe case of fetal hydrops live for more than a few hours after birth. Undeterred, Dan and Michelle and their family prayed for a miracle through the intercession of Father McGivney - and received one. That child, whom his parents, Dan and Michelle named Michael McGivney Schachle, brought up the relic of the new Blessed at his Beatification Mass in 2020. I saw him carrying forward the relic with my own eyes. There was not a dry eye (including mine) in the whole church that day.

It is so urgent that we all pray for an increased respect in our society for the gift of all human life - and especially for people with Down Syndrome, who, often - tragically - are never even given the chance to live. This weekend we as a parish are delighted to welcome the St. Robert Bellarmine Apostolate to the 11:00 Mass this Sunday, September 17th which, were it not a Sunday, would be the feast day of St. Robert Bellarmine. A first-class relic of St. Robert Bellarmine will be present on the altar for this Mass.

The mission of the St. Robert Bellarmine Apostolate is to support and strengthen individuals with Down Syndrome, their families and their caregivers through prayer. The members of the Apostolate live out this mission by:

- Praying certain intercessory prayers to St. Robert Bellarmine to increase devotion to this Saint as a patron for individuals with Down syndrome.
- Praying the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass for individuals with Down syndrome, their families and caregivers on the Sunday before or after his feast day (September 17).
- Encouraging Catholic parents to join or to form a MOMs+DADs (Mother of Mercy spiritual Divine Advocate for Down syndrome) prayer/support group at their local parishes.


