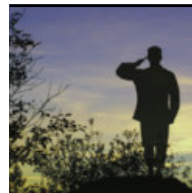

✧ A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR ✧

Dear Friends,

As you may have seen on our social media platforms, and in the bulletin last week, Deacon Toole and I were in Rome last week with Bishop Caggiano and a small group of priests from our diocese. The purpose of our time in Rome was to participate in a homiletics seminar at the Pontifical University of St. Thomas Aquinas (known colloquially as the "Angelicum") which is run by the Order of Friars Preachers, the Dominicans. We stayed at the Casa Santa Maria, which is the house in Rome near the Trevi Fountain where American priests live while they are assigned by their bishops to pursue graduate studies in Rome.

Each morning last week, we spent about three hours in class at the Angelicum, learning from the Dominican Friars about various aspects of preaching technique, structures, approaches, and spirituality. The classes themselves took place in an area of the Angelicum which was built by Pope St. Pius V, whose pontificate was from 1566 to 1572, and whose coat of arms is in our Rosary window near the shrine of the Blessed Mother. St. Pius V's feast day is April 30, which is also Deacon Toole's birthday!

Each afternoon, after lunch (or "pranzo") we went on pilgrimage to various basilicas in Rome, and we priests each took turns preaching. I was privileged to preach in the church of Sant' Agostino, in the chapel which houses the relics of St. Augustine's mother, St. Monica. Because of St. Monica's persevering prayer for her son, Augustine, he was converted from a life distant from God, and became one of the greatest saints in the history of the Church. (And, of course, patron saint of our diocese). At that Mass I prayed especially for Catholics who are away from the Church and away from the sacraments. The church of Sant' Agostino also houses a famous statue of Our Lady called the "Madonna del Parto" which for over 500 years has been a place of pilgrimage for women having difficulty conceiving, as they ask Our Lady's intercession for the gift of children, for safe pregnancies, and for safe deliveries. The many photos of babies and infants left around the statue attest to the efficacy of Our Lady's prayers.

That same day (Tuesday, February 11) was the 70th anniversary of the foundation of our parish. Our group went that afternoon to the Basilica of Santa Maria sopra Minerva to pray very specially at the tomb of our patroness, St. Catherine of Siena, thanking God for the blessings of these seven decades, and asking her intercession for all that lies ahead. Later in the week, our group visited the Pontifical North American College, where American seminarians study, and were given a tour of that very impressive facility by the Rector, Msgr. Thomas Powers, who is a priest of our diocese. The rooftop of the PNAC has *the* best view of the city of Rome, and a breathtaking view of St. Peter's Basilica.

It was also a week of wonderful priestly fraternity, lots of laughs, warm conversation, and just enjoying each other's company, together with our Bishop. Needless to say, the food in Rome was pretty good too and the gelato every evening was fantastic!

Please keep in your prayers the priests who were blessed to go on last week's seminar pilgrimage to Rome, as well as the benefactor whose generosity made the experience possible for us.

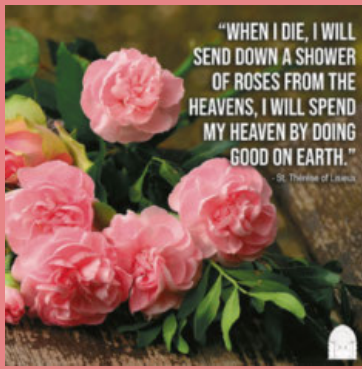

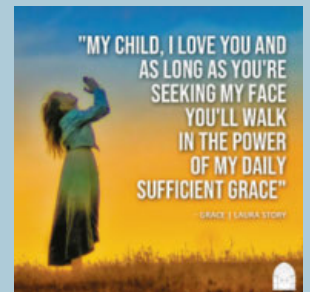

THE EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME: Jesus told his disciples a parable, "Can a blind person guide a blind person? Will not both fall into a pit? No disciple is superior to the teacher; but when fully trained, every disciple will be like his teacher. Why do you notice the splinter in your brother's eye, but do not perceive the wooden beam in your own? 
