

Dear Friends,

Just last week we celebrated Father's Day. And every father knows that part of his responsibility is figuring out and providing for the maintenance, upkeep, and repairs of his family's home and property. That is very much true here at our parish too.

So, following so soon upon Father's Day, I am happy to share with you the news that -- thanks to your generosity to the Annual Parish Appeal over the last two years -- we are now in a position to move forward with completely replacing the side parking lot on the north end of our campus.

The side parking lot was installed by Father Richard Monahan, the 3rd pastor of St. Catherine's, in the early 1980s. It has served us well, but by now it is crumbling. Just since I've been here, we have had to patch it many times. Every summer - by August or so - it is a mess of weeds because it is so cracked.

Beginning on Monday, June 23, the side parking lot will be scraped up, and a new parking lot of the same size and dimensions will be poured and finished. It will need a bit of time to cure, and then, once the parking lines are painted onto it, it will be ready for use, which will be in mid-July.





With the newly renovated Marian Prayer Garden, that whole side of our campus will be brand new, significantly upgraded, and especially beautiful.

I want to emphasize that it is through your generosity that we are able to do all this. No one subsidizes our parish for anything, so whenever we make improvements, it is up to all of us to come together to provide for our common home. We do so not only for ourselves and our families, but also for those who will come after us.

Thank you for doing that so magnificently, over and over again.

Parking lots are not as exciting as statues or altars or stained glass windows, but they are very necessary. So, a warm word of thanks to everyone whose generosity has made this possible.
