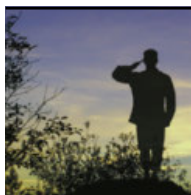

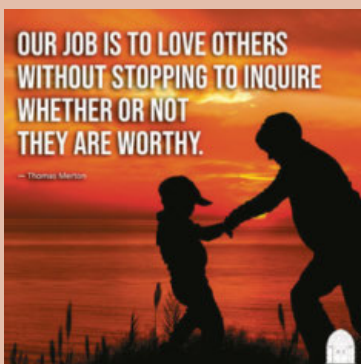

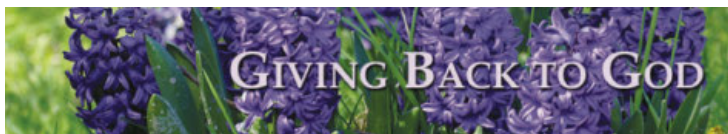
We're all enjoying warmer weather, relaxed schedules, & summer celebrations. A few thoughts, during this warm & wonderful season:
