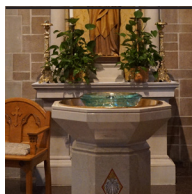

## ✧ A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR ✧

Dear Friends,

Two days after he was elected to the papacy last May, Pope Leo XIV paid a surprise visit to a town about 40 miles southeast of Rome called Genazzano.

He did that because Genazzano is home to the Sanctuary of our Lady of Good Counsel, which since 1356 has been in the care of the Augustinian Order. Pope Leo is the first Pope from the Augustinian Order in history. In truth, I had never heard of Genazzano or the Sanctuary of our Lady of Good Counsel before Pope Leo's visit there, but a few months later, it was my privilege to visit Genazzano and to say Mass on the altar of the miraculous image.

On April 25, 1467, the feast of St. Mark, a mysterious cloud is said to have descended on an old, deteriorated church in Genazzano which was dedicated to Our Lady of Good Counsel and was under renovation by the Augustinians. When the cloud dissipated, a delicate image of the Blessed Virgin Mary and the Child Jesus was found on a very thin sheet of plaster, about 18 inches square. Seemingly it hung in midair, suspended without support.

The image was thought to date to apostolic times, having been miraculously transported to Italy from a church in Albania, just before the invasion of the Ottoman Turks there, in that same year. However, tests done in the 1950s indicated that the image was ancient, but not as ancient as originally thought, and seems to have been painted over before being rediscovered when a poor widow gave all she had to fund the renovation of the church.

Regardless of how the image of arrived in Genazzano, in the months following the appearance of the image, prodigious miracles began to occur, including physical healings, all manner of answered prayers, and the complete conversion of many who had been distant from God and from the Church. Much of the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Good Counsel was destroyed during World War II, but the image remained intact and unmoved. Today the image is housed above an altar in a small chapel within the Sanctuary, and the chapel is surrounded by a strong iron grille.

When I was there, I thought of the many pilgrims who had come there to pray, including: on October 21, 1630, Pope Urban VIII (who consecrated the "new" St Peter's Basilica and built the monumental baldachino over the main altar and the tomb of St. Peter),

St. John Bosco, who said Mass on the altar on March 27, 1858, Blessed Pius IX, on August 15, 1864, Pope St. John XXIII, on August 25, 1959, and Pope St. John Paul II, on April 22, 1993.

This is the message I left in the guest book in the sacristy of the Shrine:

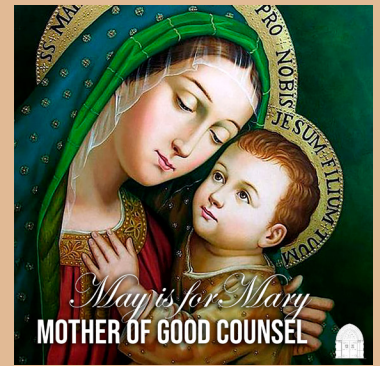
