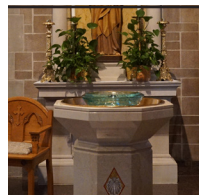

## ✧ A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR ✧

Dear Friends,

Happy Mother's Day! Today we give God thanks for the gift of motherhood, and the gift of our own Mothers, Grandmothers, and Godmothers, those on earth, and those who have already passed into eternity.

Above all we honor today the best and most loving of all mothers, the Blessed Mother. This May, let's all find some way of making this month truly special, honoring Our Lady in some specific, intentional way, from our hearts.

If you don't already have a statue of Our Lady in your home or in your yard... get one! Get one this month! It would be very appropriate to decorate a statue of Our Lady in our home or in our yard with flowers and candles this month. This is a beautiful way not only of honoring Our Lady, but also of drawing down God's grace through her hands.

St. Pio of Pietrelcina ("Padre Pio") once said, "Some people are so foolish that they think they can go through life without the help of the Blessed Mother. Love Our Lady very much, and pray the Rosary, for the Rosary is the weapon against the evils of the world today. All graces given by God pass through the Blessed Mother."

Another beautiful thing for this month is to learn more about the appearances of Our Lady in the world in recent centuries. Her message has been similar in all the places she has appeared: that it is necessary to pray and to do penance to obtain peace for the world and graces for those who are distant from God and in danger of eternal damnation. Some of Our Lady's appearances which have been investigated by the Church and found worthy of belief are:

- Our Lady of Guadalupe (Mexico City, 1531)
- Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal (Rue du Bac - Paris, France, 1830)
- Our Lady of Lourdes (Lourdes, France, 1858)

We at St. Catherine's have a special devotion to Our Lady of Lourdes, because it was on the anniversary of her first appearance at Lourdes, and her feast day, February 11, in 1955, that our parish was canonically established.

- Our Lady of Good Help (Champion, Wisconsin, 1859)

This is the only approved Marian apparition to have taken place in the United States of America.

- Our Lady of Knock (Knock, Ireland, 1879)
- Our Lady of Fátima (Fátima, Portugal, 1917)
- Our Lady of Banneux (Banneux, Belgium, 1933)

St. John Paul II said: "To succeed in your intentions, entrust yourself to the Blessed Virgin Mary always, but especially in moments of difficulty and darkness. From Mary we learn to surrender to God's will in all things. From Mary we learn to trust, even when all hope seems gone. From Mary we learn to love Christ, her Son and the Son of God. Learn from her to be always faithful, to trust that God's Word to you will be fulfilled, and that nothing is impossible with God."

## YOUNG ADULT FAITH IN ACTION

A vibrant young adult ministry in Stamford is helping young Catholics, like Thomas Angiolollo, deepen their faith and find meaningful community within the Church.
