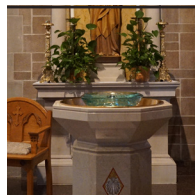

MAKE YOUR DONATION: Our Online Giving Platform will accept your donations for Mass intentions; please use the **"Memorial Masses"** fund for Mass Intention or **"Sanctuary Lamp"** fund for Sanctuary Lamp.

Announced Mass intentions are customarily for deceased persons. Should anyone desire to request a Mass for a living person or persons, such requests will be addressed individually by the parish office.

We cannot accommodate all requests, as there are about 500 intoned Masses available each year, and we receive easily twice that number of requests! In order to be fair to all, it is our parish's policy that an individual family may request up to five (5) Masses in a calendar year, including: up to two (2) weekend Masses, & up to three (3) weekday Masses. For a Mass intention, either one (1) or two (2) individual names may be listed as the intention for a Mass. Should the person requesting the Mass desire more than two names, the Mass should be designated for all the deceased members of that family. Thank you for your kind understanding. It is a great "problem" to have that so many people want to request Masses at our parish!
