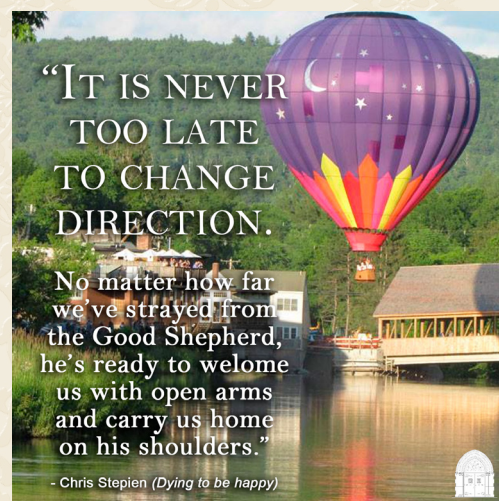
Getting More Out of Your Confession

Dear Friends,

As we announce each weekend, the Sacrament of Confession is available here at St. Catherine's every Tuesday evening, from 6 to 8 pm. Whenever someone goes to confession, it is certain that God is already at work in their life - even before the forgiveness takes place. Conversion is a work of the grace of God, who always invites us to return to Him. In Confession, God rejoices to welcome a repentant sinner back to His love and mercy. After Confession, God wants to bring that work to fulfillment through a life of true peace, joy, freedom, and love. I am happy to offer here some practical ideas for cooperating with God's work in your soul, and getting more out of your Confession.

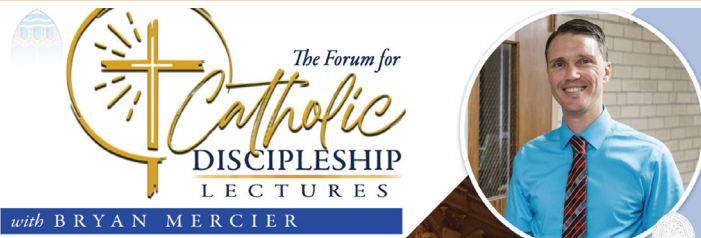
1. **EXAMINE YOUR CONSCIENCE DAILY.** Before going to bed, briefly recall the past day. Thank God for the good you have done, ask forgiveness for any sins, and ask His grace to do better tomorrow.
2. **GO TO CONFESSION MONTHLY.** The minimum requirement for a practicing Catholic is to go to confession once a year, but confessing every month or two helps us to better form our conscience, overcome our sins, and grow in God's grace.
3. **SEEK A MORE PERFECT CONTRITION.** Contrition is a sorrow of soul for the sins committed, and it includes the firm resolution to sin no more. Aim towards a more perfect contrition, making God's love the motive for your sorrow and resolve, rather than fear of hell or a desire for relief from the feelings of guilt and shame.
4. **MAKE CONCRETE RESOLUTIONS TO AMEND YOUR LIFE.** The firm resolution to sin no more includes taking concrete steps to avoid sin and practice virtue. Consider these or similar resolutions: establishing a prayer routine, making and sticking to a balanced / disciplined schedule of study, work, and leisure, installing porn filters on your devices, and so forth.
5. **EVANGELIZE.** Share the peace and joy that you receive from Confession by encouraging others to go as well. Consider inviting a friend to come with you.
6. **DEEPEN YOUR RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD.** The peace and joy of a deep spiritual life causes everything else, including temptation, to pale in comparison. Growing in your spiritual life through daily prayer will bear great fruit in your moral life.
7. **ADD TO YOUR EXAMINATION OF CONSCIENCE A "PARTICULAR EXAMEN."** Examining the past day with a focus on a particular virtue that you want to develop is a great way to respond to struggles with a particular vice or sin.
8. **MAKE FASTING AND SACRIFICE A REGULAR SPIRITUAL PRACTICE.** Fasting and sacrifice atone for sin, strengthen us against temptation, and honor the Passion of Christ. Be intentional about taking up some form of self-denial on Fridays to intentionally unite yourself with the Passion of Christ.
9. **PRACTICE DEVOTIONS AND ACTS OF REPARATION.** Spiritual practices such as the Rosary, the Chaplet of the Divine Mercy, and devotions to the Sacred Heart of Jesus are great examples of devotion and reparation. These help us to express more genuinely our sorrow for sin and receive more fruitfully the grace we need to fulfill our resolutions of amendment.
10. **MAKE THE MOST OUT OF YOUR TIME IN LINE!** Capitalize on the time spent waiting in line for Confession by preparing well to make a clear, concise, and thorough confession, mentioning all sins in number and kind, but avoiding extraneous talk, out of respect for the people behind you in line. Praying the Rosary for the other people in line with you is a beautiful act of charity as well, known only to you and to God.

Sun, Sep 27: 7:30am, 9am, 11am & 7pm: Mass in the presence of the Relics, followed by Veneration.

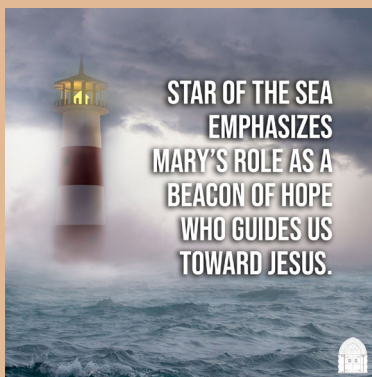

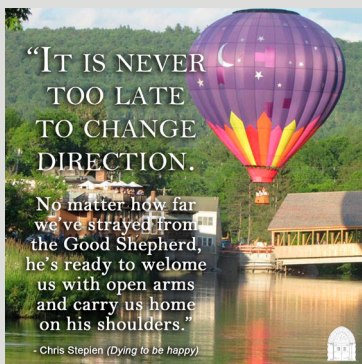

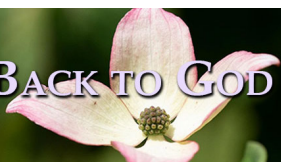

TWENTY-FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Peter approached Jesus and asked him, "Lord, if my brother sins against me, how often must I forgive? As many as seven times?" Jesus answered, "I say to you, not seven times but seventy-seven times. That is why the kingdom of heaven may be likened to a king who decided to settle accounts with his servants. When he began the accounting, a debtor was brought before him who owed him a huge amount. Since he had no way of paying it back, his master ordered him to be sold, along with his wife, his children, and all his property, in payment of the debt. At that, the servant fell down, did him homage, and said, 'Be patient with me, and I will pay you back in full.' Moved with compassion the master of that servant let him go and forgave him the loan. When that servant had left, he found one of his fellow servants who owed him a much smaller amount. He seized him and started to choke him, demanding, 'Pay back what you owe.' Falling to his knees, his fellow servant begged him, 'Be patient with me, and I will pay you back.' But he refused. Instead, he had the fellow servant put in prison until he paid back the debt. Now when his fellow servants saw what had happened, they were deeply disturbed, and went to their master and reported the whole affair. His master summoned him and said to him, 'You wicked servant! I forgave you your entire debt because you begged me to. Should you not have had pity on your fellow servant, as I had pity on you?' Then in anger his master handed him over to the torturers until he should pay back the whole debt. So will my heavenly Father do to you, unless each of you forgives your brother from your heart.'" *Matthew 18: 21-35*
