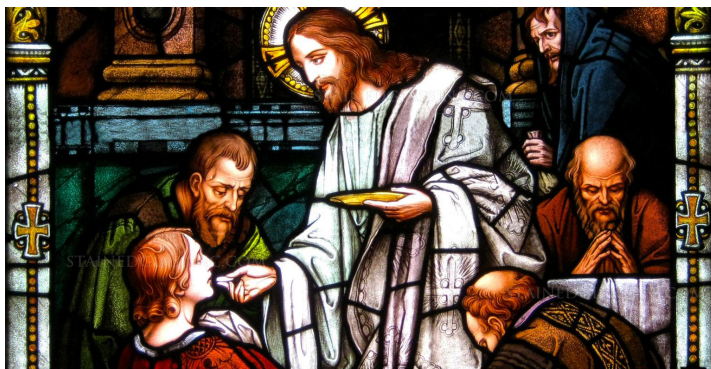

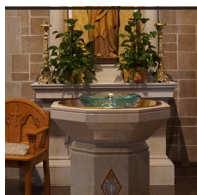

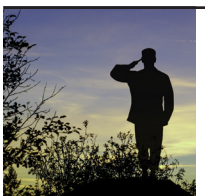

✧ A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR ✧

Kickoff WEeekend

Dear Friends,

Welcome to Kickoff Weekend!

Longtime parishioners and friends have heard me say a thousand times: "A special word of welcome to everyone who's visiting us this weekend, or anyone who's new to our parish." I say that so often because we can never offer these words of welcome often enough.

Why? Pope Francis said at the beginning of his service as the Pastor of the Universal Church: "The joy of the Gospel fills the hearts and lives of all who encounter Jesus. Those who accept his offer of salvation are set free from sin, sorrow, inner emptiness and loneliness. With Christ joy is constantly born anew." That is the truth, and it is experienced by all who truly encounter the Lord. We want everyone to experience that – and that's what a Catholic parish is for: to be a place that makes possible a deep encounter with Jesus Christ so that as many people as possible can come to know and love Him in this life, and dwell with Him in eternity.



This passage is attributed to the famous Jesuit Superior General, Father Pedro Arrupe S.J.:

Nothing is more practical than finding God, than falling in Love in a quite absolute, final way. What you are in love with, what seizes your imagination, will affect everything. It will decide what will get you out of bed in the morning, what you do with your evenings, how you spend your weekends, what you read, whom you know, what breaks your heart, and what amazes you with joy and gratitude. Fall in Love, stay in love, and it will decide everything.

It is only in the context of this encounter, of this love, that we can come to see and experience the Commandments and the Beatitudes not as context-less restrictions, but as the liberating guideposts for healthy and noble living that they really are. Otherwise, absent this encounter, the whole structure really does seem like just rules. And then, when people walk away from the Faith, they are almost always walking away not from the Faith itself, but from the superficial caricature for which they mistake the Faith.

Every parish is meant to be a school of prayer: a place where we can encounter the Lord very deeply and profoundly. So, if you're a parishioner, I invite you to invite someone you know who's searching for a spiritual home (whether they realize it or not) to experience for themselves what makes our parish so special. Ultimately, what makes our parish so special is Jesus Christ, together with our family of faith which is so welcoming and so generous in outreach and service. And, if you're new, or searching, or visiting, I invite you to take a look around, to ask questions. You are welcome here.

None of us is perfect, and you don't have to be perfect to belong here. God's mercy meets us exactly where we are right now – but it doesn't leave us there. God calls us, and walks with us, and leads us to a life that is more and more reflective of the dignity that is ours as His children; more and more human and free, because more and more conformed to Christ.

So, whether you've been here for a while, or whether you'd like to join us on this adventure, or whether you know anyone else who would, I say: Welcome! And let's begin.

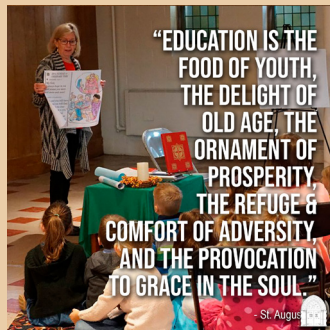

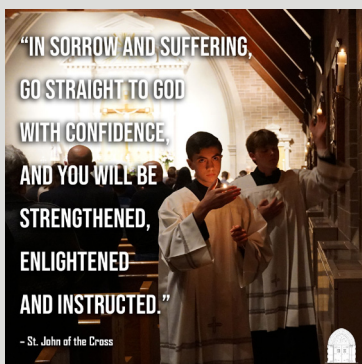

TWENTY-FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Jesus told his disciples this parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like a landowner who went out at dawn to hire laborers for his vineyard. After agreeing with them for the usual daily wage, he sent them into his vineyard. Going out about nine o'clock, the landowner saw others standing idle in the marketplace, and he said to them, 'You too go into my vineyard, and I will give you what is just.' So they went off. And he went out again around noon, and around three o'clock, and did likewise. Going out about five o'clock, the landowner found others standing around, and said to them, 'Why do you stand here idle all day?' They answered, 'Because no one has hired us.' He said to them, 'You too go into my vineyard.' When it was evening the owner of the vineyard said to his foreman, 'Summon the laborers and give them their pay, beginning with the last and ending with the first.' When those who had started about five o'clock came, each received the usual daily wage. So when the first came, they thought that they would receive more, but each of them also got the usual wage. And on receiving it they grumbled against the landowner, saying, 'These last ones worked only one hour, and you have made them equal to us, who bore the day's burden and the heat.' He said to one of them in reply, 'My friend, I am not cheating you. Did you not agree with me for the usual daily wage? Take what is yours and go. What if I wish to give this last one the same as you? Or am I not free to do as I wish with my own money? Are you envious because I am generous?' Thus, the last will be first, and the first will be last."

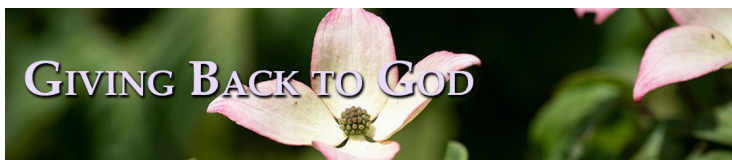

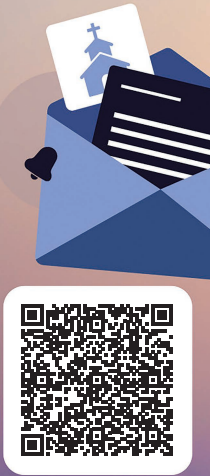
