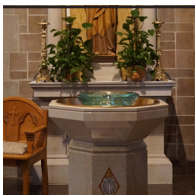

✧ A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR ✧

Dear Friends,

Many long-time parishioners remember Bishop Fulton J. Sheen's award-winning television show, *Life is Worth Living*. In his day, Bishop Sheen was the foremost explainer and promoter of the Catholic Faith in the United States. When our church was under construction in the 1950s, Bishop Sheen presented a fundraising lecture at the Shakespeare Festival Theater in Stratford, the proceeds of which benefitted the Church Building Fund for Saint Catherine of Siena Parish. The presentation was so successful that our first pastor, Father Halloran, designated the sanctuary of Saint Catherine of Siena Church as a gift of Bishop Sheen, in gratitude for his kindness to our parish.

I share this with you because recently I was reminded of an exceptionally thoughtful passage from the writings of Bishop Sheen, applicable to anyone who experiences any kind of pain or suffering. It is a prayer to Jesus. What I find especially helpful is the connection Bishop Sheen makes between everyday life and the Eucharist.

When we understand this connection, the Mass really comes alive. Then Mass is no longer a matter of "watching" the priest at the altar; rather, *all of us together* unite our lives to the life of Christ, and the sacrifices of our daily lives are assimilated to Christ's sacrifice, which was once offered on Calvary and is made present on the altar in every Mass.

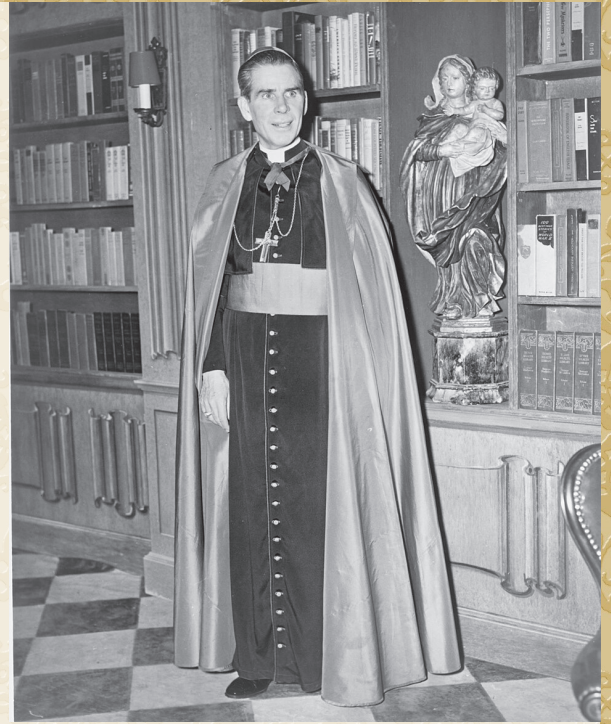
Bishop Sheen writes:

There is nothing more tragic in all the world than wasted pain. Think of how much suffering there is in hospitals, among the poor and bereaved. Think also of how much of that suffering goes to waste. How many of those lonesome, suffering, abandoned, crucified souls are saying with our Lord at the moment of Consecration: "This is my body, take it!"? And yet, that is what we should be saying at that second:

"Here is my body, take it. Here is my soul, my will, my energy, my strength, my poverty, my wealth – all that I have. It is yours. Take it! Consecrate it! Offer it! Offer it, Lord Jesus, to the Heavenly Father with yourself, in order that he, looking down on this great Sacrifice, may see only you, his beloved Son, in whom he is well pleased. Transmute the poor bread of my life into your life; thrill the wine of my wasted life into your divine Spirit; unite my broken heart with your Heart; change my cross into a crucifix.

Let not my abandonment and my sorrow go to waste. Gather up the fragments, and as the drop of water is absorbed by the wine at the Offertory of the Mass, let my life be absorbed in you. Let my little cross be entwined with your great cross, so that I may purchase the joys of everlasting happiness in union with you.

Consecrate these trials of my life which would go unrewarded unless united with you; transubstantiate me so that, like bread which is now your Body, and wine which is now your Blood, I, too, may be wholly yours. I care not if the species remain, or that, like the bread and wine, I may seem to all earthly eyes the same as before. My station in life, my routine duties, my work, my family – all these are but the species of my life which may remain unchanged; but the substance of my life, my soul, my will, my heart, transubstantiate them, transform them wholly into your service so that through me all may know how sweet is the love of Christ!

MAJOR RELICS OF ST. MARGARET MARY ALACOQUE

The relics will be present for all five Masses on Oct 3 & 4. Veneration available immediately following.

The major relics of St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, a cloistered, contemplative nun known as the Apostle of the Sacred Heart, are traveling in the U.S. under the custody of the Knights of Columbus. The tour celebrates the U.S. Catholic bishops' consecration of the nation to the Sacred Heart in June for our country's 250th. St. Margaret Mary was a member of a religious community known as the Order of the Visitation of Holy Mary. Beginning in 1673, at her convent in France, she experienced multiple visions of Jesus during which he stressed his divine love for humanity and revealed devotion to his Sacred Heart. At Jesus' instruction, and with the assistance of her priest spiritual director, the Jesuit priest St. Claude de la Colombiere, the nun introduced the series of spiritual practices to the world which continue to be observed today. She was canonized as a saint in 1920.

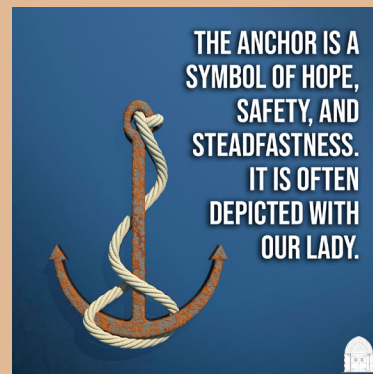
